## President's Report

The 2007 year was one of contrast and mixed fortunes for the Box Hill Hawks Football Club. Our Senior team won four-and-a-half games and finished second last on the ladder, our worst on-field performance in two decades. Off the field, the Club grew all areas of its operations and continued to strengthen its financial position.

In 2006 our Senior team did not participate in the Finals for the first time since 1999. Arising from this, the Board conducted a full review of our Football operations at the end of the season. We concluded that we had fallen behind the standard of some A.F.L. / V.F.L. Club alignments and that additional financial and personnel resources needed to be directed into our Football department. During the early years of the revamped V.F.L. competition our Club was very much a pacesetter, however, other Clubs have in recent years copied many aspects of the Hawthorn / Box Hill Hawks model and in some cases have managed to surpass us due to greater financial capacity.

Coupled with this problem was the youth and inexperience of Hawthorn's A.F.L. list. Aligned V.F.L. Clubs must be honest with themselves; their on-field prospects are heavily linked to the quality of A.F.L. listed players likely to play in the V.F.L. In recent years Hawthorn has rebuilt its playing list, aggressively trading experienced players past their prime for early draft picks and drafting young talent. The result for the Box Hill Hawks was that nearly all the Hawthorn listed players who represented us in 2007 had less than ten A.F.L. games under their belt. A telling statistic during 2007 was that on several occasions we played opposing Clubs with more than 1,000 games of A.F.L. experience in their team, more often than not the Box Hill Hawks team had less than 100 games of A.F.L. experience.

The Board anticipated these issues and determined that the Club needed to recruit some experienced Footballers for 2007 to be competitive. A new financial structure was negotiated with Hawthorn's Football Department and the player budget was set at 93% of the V.F.L. salary cap, far and away the highest in my nineteen years involvement with the Club. The resulting recruiting drive met with limited success; we were able to entice Nick Smith (ex-Melbourne), Kris Shore (ex-Kangaroos) and Matthew Ball (ex-Hawthorn) to sign with the Box Hill Hawks. In the case of Matthew Ball, we knew that he would only be able to give us half a season due to overseas study commitments, but the prospect of him becoming the first Box Hill player in eight years to achieve the milestone of 100 Senior games convinced us that signing him was the right thing to do.

Aside from the players that we were able to recruit, we naturally hoped that further improvement from the existing Box Hill Hawks listed players would help us to climb the ladder, particularly from those who had carried our Reserves team to the 2006 Premiership. From my perspective the lack of development in many of these players was one of the great disappointments of the season. Of the twenty-two players who played in the victorious Grand Final team, only five played more than five Senior games in 2007 – Marcus Crook, Steven Daniher, Richard Eva, Sam Gibson and Evan Johnson.

Our off-season optimism of an improved season in 2007 was shattered by a 21-goal defeat in our opening game against Casey. From then on the Senior team was never able to gain any momentum or consistent winning form. For long periods in most games we were competitive; a frequent occurrence underlining our inexperience was a loss by four or five goals with the team conceding the winning margin during a ten or fifteen minute lapse.

Victories over the minor Premier (Sandringham) and eventual Premier (Geelong) showed the Box Hill Hawks was not devoid of talent, however, we were only able to manage two wins and a draw from the other sixteen matches. Our lack of midfield run was underlined by the fact that only one match was won on our M.C.G. sized home ground; included in our losses at City Oval were unforgivable performances against wooden-spooner Tasmania and stand-alone Frankston. Our lack of goal scoring firepower was a major Achilles heel with our only score during the season of more than 100 points being achieved in the dying minutes of the final game.

Our Reserves team enjoyed another consistent season, reaching the Finals for a third consecutive year. Unfortunately the team was not able to repeat the heroics of 2006, bowing out in a high-standard and high-scoring Elimination Final. I believe that we have made significant advances in recent years rebuilding the depth of the Box Hill Hawks list. My concern is how we go about enticing the right players to our Club to fill the first six or so places on our list. These players need to be good enough to be on an A.F.L. list, must be team leaders and role models to the Box Hill Hawks and Hawthorn listed players and their skills must compliment the contingent of A.F.L. listed players that will regularly be part of our Senior team. Clearly recruiting and the way we attract these types of players to the Box Hill Hawks are the areas that need to be addressed and the Board is fully focused on working with the Football department to ensure that the best possible outcomes are achieved in these areas.

I congratulate all our trophy winners in 2007, particularly our Club Champion, Nick Smith, who in his first year with the Box Hill Hawks fully lived up to the reputation that he brought to our Club earned as an A.F.L. player and V.F.L. Premiership player. I also congratulate and acknowledge the achievement of Matthew Ball who became the first Box Hill Hawks player in the eight years since the restructuring of the V.F.L. competition to reach the wonderful milestone of 100 Senior games for our Club. A dual Box Hill Hawks Club Champion and Premiership player, his class and place as one of our all-time elite players was underlined when he finished as Runner-Up Club Champion this year despite only playing in the first ten games. All Box Hill Hawks supporters like to dream that he again play for us after returning from overseas, if not, we have all been fortunate to witness one of the great playing careers for our Club.

The Board had not yet completed its review of 2007 when Damien Christensen advised us that he would not seek reappointment as Senior Coach for a third season. On behalf of all at the Club, I thank Damien for his contribution during a difficult phase of Box Hill's and Hawthorn's list development. As I said at our Presentation Night in acknowledging Damien's efforts, my hope is that his legacy at the Box Hill Hawks is that many of the young players he has blooded over the past two years will become integral in our Club's next push to the upper rungs of the V.F.L. ladder. I also thank our Reserves Coach, Kevin Tibaldi, who is departing the Club to take on a senior coaching role in the Eastern Football League. Kevin has made a significant contribution to our Club in two stints and, of course, is one of the few people in our long history that can claim the honour of being a Premiership coach.

I am delighted to confirm that the Club has appointed Barry Mitchell as Senior Coach for the 2008 Season. Barry has impeccable credentials as V.F.L. coach, having been an assistant coach at Carlton for five years and Senior Coach of the Northern Bullants during the past four seasons. We are confident that he is the right man to lead the Box Hill Hawks back into Finals contention in the very near future.

Off the field, the Club has experienced another most satisfactory year. Our fifth consecutive operating profit, with the past two years each producing profits of in excess of \$30,000, was an outstanding achievement, particularly when it is considered that these results have been achieved without one cent of gaming income. In recent years we have developed a business model that works and full credit must be given to Andrew Pirchan and Bob Lyford who are charged with the responsibility of carrying out the Board's policies. I have said it in this Report before, but we as a Club are extremely fortunate to have two such competent administrators looking after our day-to-day operations.

The other outstanding aspect of 2007 was the completion by Whitehorse Council of three more significant projects at Box Hill City Oval of total value well in excess of \$1,000,000. A long-term goal was achieved when the Cricket practice wickets were removed from the playing arena. Having to play away from home for the first three rounds of the season was a very small price to pay for such an outstanding improvement to the City Oval playing surface that will provide enormous benefit to our Club for years to come.



In Bolton Park, Council also installed a filtration plant and underground water tanks of 1,000,000 Litre capacity to collect stormwater from City Oval buildings and surrounding streets to be used for watering City Oval. In these days of drought and water restrictions, this is an outstanding initiative that should ensure that City Oval is always maintained in a standard befitting of a State League venue.

Finally, Council upgraded the main spectator entrance at Whitehorse Road with two ticket boxes and expanded car parking, both from a visual and functional consideration a magnificent improvement to our home ground. The "Ron and Barbara Gibbs Entrance" was officially opened by the Mayor, Cr. Koutras, on Anzac Day. The benefits were instantly felt as the holiday crowd of 3,178 was admitted to the ground quickly and efficiently without any of the queuing problems experienced in the past when we have hosted big crowds. Personally, it was a privilege to take part in the naming ceremony and to join with the entire local community that thanked Barbara Gibbs and her family for their decades of service to our Club, tinged with a little sadness that Ron Gibbs is no longer with us to receive such a richly deserved honour.

On behalf of all associated with the Box Hill Hawks Football Club, I sincerely thank Whitehorse Council for their magnificent support and for sharing our vision of making Box Hill City Oval a Victorian showpiece for community sport. I am delighted to note that Council has included a capital works allocation totalling \$600,000 in its 2007/2008 and 2008/2009 budgets towards the construction of the long-planned new pavilion and clubrooms at City Oval. In conjunction with \$700,000 offered by Football stakeholders (A.F.L. Victoria, Hawthorn Football Club and the Box Hill Hawks Football Club), there is now a realistic prospect that this project will be funded and completed in the foreseeable future. A momentous achievement was reached in March this year when this Club was able to sign an agreement with the Box Hill Cricket Club for the future development of Box Hill City Oval and on-going sharing arrangements for the venue. We still have some issues to resolve with Council, in particular the terms of a long-term lease City Oval that would enable the release of funding from Football stakeholders, but we have certainly made much progress during the past year.

Another highlight during the year that recognised great service to the Box Hill Hawks Football Club was the unfurling of the 2006 V.F.L. Reserve Grade Premiership pennant by Life Member, Elaine Brown. Elaine has been a great worker for and friend of this Club for three decades and rarely, if ever, misses a Box Hill Hawks match, so it was most appropriate that she was accorded the honour of unfurling our first ever Reserve Grade flag.

At a strategic level, clearly the most difficult issue for the V.F.L. competition and its member Clubs to deal with during 2007 was the A.F.L.'s National Review of Second Tier Football. After meandering along for over eighteen months, a Review Panel was appointed in February. It quickly became apparent that the term "National" was a misnomer, the review was really Victorian based, in particular, of the V.F.L. and T.A.C. Cup competitions.

Fuelled by public comments by coaches of Melbourne-based A.F.L. Clubs, much of the publicity surrounding the Review was unhelpful, disrespectful and damaging to the V.F.L. competition. Speculation about the resurrection of the A.F.L. Reserves competition, the demise of many existing alignments and even some V.F.L. Clubs created much uncertainty and impacted adversely on the relationship between V.F.L. Clubs and their major stakeholders, in particular, local Councils and sponsors.

Much of the media comment that surrounded the Review reminded me of the old truism that if an untruth is repeated often enough then everyone will believe it. The view expressed repeatedly was that Melbourne based A.F.L. Clubs are disadvantaged compared with their interstate rivals as they lose control over their players' development in the V.F.L. system and that V.F.L. Clubs are too focused on winning rather than player development to the detriment of A.F.L. listed players. In fact, Melbourne based A.F.L. Clubs exert much more influence over the operation of the V.F.L. competition through alignment partnerships than their interstate rivals fielding players in the W.A.F.L. or S.A.N.F.L. could ever dream of.

I challenge anyone to name one A.F.L. listed player who's development has been sacrificed by a V.F.L. coach on the altar of four V.F.L. Premiership points. Certainly there is no problem with the standard of the V.F.L. competition, which has regularly defeated the W.A.F.L. and S.A.N.F.L. in recent years, in 2007 thrashing the W.A.F.L. by 20 goals.

The recommendations of the Second Tier Review committee, when released in late-July, included a reaffirmation that regional State-based leagues are a preferable model to a national A.F.L. Reserves competition and that alignments between A.F.L. and V.F.L. Clubs will remain a key component of the Second Tier structure. Furthermore, it advocated full integration between V.F.L. and T.A.C. Cup Clubs to create strong regional talent pathways and focussed investment to improve regional talent development structures.

These recommendations are supported by this Club which we believe, if properly implemented, will further enhance the role played by the V.F.L. competition as part of the talent pathway. However, of great concern are recent indications by the A.F.L. that it wishes to replace the independent Board of A.F.L. Victoria with an A.F.L.-appointed advisory panel. I believe that Football in this State must retain its independence and autonomy from the nationally focused A.F.L. if it is to flourish at all levels.

In the tumult that surrounded the A.F.L. Second Tier Review, it says a lot that the Hawthorn – Box Hill Hawks partnership was one of the very few alignments about which there was no media speculation regarding its demise. I am pleased to say that, after eight years, the relationship is as strong as ever. I acknowledge the support of the President of the Hawthorn Football Club, Hon. Jeff Kennett, and key staff members; Ian Robson (Chief Executive), Mark Evans (General Manager Football Operations), Terry Dillon (Chief Operating Officer) and Glenn Thornton (Financial Accountant) who were again available to assist our Club wherever possible.

To the businesses that generously support the Box Hill Hawks Football Club, I again express our sincere gratitude. We are fortunate to a number of long-term sponsors who are both generous and enthusiastic about their involvement with this Club. In particular I acknowledge our Major Sponsor, Budget Car and Truck Rental. A full listing of all those businesses and organisations that support our Club is on the inside front cover of this Annual Report.

I thank my fellow Box Hill Hawks Directors for their efforts and contribution towards the smooth operation of the Club. I say without hesitation that the Club's present administration is the best that I have been part of during my association with the Club. In particular I acknowledge Jim Conway, now officially my Vice-President, for deputising for me on occasions when I was unavailable and Peter Rowsthorn who, after contributing strongly to the Board for the past four years, has advised that he will be standing down at the end of the year.

To our support staff and volunteers, thank you once again for your efforts. This Club would not be able to function without you. It is interesting to note, from the Staff List on page 2 of this Annual Report, that we have considerably more off-field helpers than players. Each and every one of you do your part to make the Box Hill Hawks Football Club the professional State League Club that it is today.

Finally, I thank the Box Hill Hawks Football Club's Members and Directors for once again granting me the honour of being President of this great Club. It is daunting to know that a sixth year in 2008 will make me this Club's third longest serving President. While I must be honest with everyone and state that I really believe that I am closer to the end of my Presidency than the start, I am happy to serve for another year if that is the will of our Members and Directors. To all, my best wishes for a very Merry Christmas and a happy and prosperous New Year in 2008.

## Community Partnerships

In 2007 the Box Hill Hawks Football Club embarked on a new and exciting programme, extending its involvement within the local community by aligning itself with specific not-for-profit organisations and forming Community Partnerships.

A review of our previous community involvement identified that the Club had supported and participated in numerous community based charity events for many years. However, our approach in the past was completely ad-hoc, driven by various requests at hand and, as such, focused outcomes were not achieved and there was little broader knowledge or recognition of our community participation.

The purpose of the Club aligning with key charities was so that we could be pro-active rather than reactive in developing meaningful community partnerships. Instead of spreading our wings far and wide throughout the community and therefore diluting our efforts, we could focus on a smaller number of programmes developed in conjunction with selected Community Partners, therefore achieving far better results.

The main criteria in selecting these organisations were that they were locally based and that their activities and involvement within the community did not conflict with one another. The Box Hill Hawks Football Club's Community Partners during 2007 were the Whitehorse Community Chest, Epworth Eastern Hospital, Reach Out For Kids and Life Education.

All in all, the Box Hill Hawks Football Club is delighted with the success of its inaugural Community Partnerships programme in 2007 and looks forward to increasing its involvement with these groups in the coming years.

An overview of the activities undertaken with our Community Partners during 2007 is as follows:

### Life Education

Life Education aims to empower young people to make safe and informed decisions about drugs and their health. Facilitated by specialist educators, who use innovative and interactive teaching strategies, Life Education develops young people's life skills, knowledge and confidence.

Reaching approximately 200,000 children and 18,000 families each year through family and school-based programs, Life Education is the largest independent, not-for-profit drug education organisation in Australia.

After an extremely successful Life Education Community Day last season, the Club is again looking at ways to support Life Education in a pro-active manner in 2008.

### Reach Out For Kids

Reach Out For Kids' (ROK) mission is to enhance the quality of life for children, young people, and families in the local community. The organisation provides strength-based support in the form of expert advice or information and counselling. A group service is also offered that promotes enhancing the well being of children.

The Club held a ROK Day at Box Hill City Oval on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> August for its final home game of the season against Werribee. The purpose of the day was to simply educate sponsors and supporters on the various programs ROK has to offer.

In addition, the Club also supported ROK's major fundraiser, its Dinner Auction, by attending as well as donating some items.

### Whitehorse Community Chest

The Whitehorse Community Chest has been supporting less fortunate citizens in the Whitehorse area for over forty-five years. The donations that it receives from the local community are distributed to over seventy different charities and community organisations active amongst the local community, including St. Vincent de Paul, the Red Cross, the Child and Family Care Network and the Cerebral Palsy Education Centre.

To help spread the word about the organisation's Annual Door Knock Appeal, the Club held a Whitehorse Community Chest Day at Box Hill City Oval on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> May for the ABC TV Match of the Day played against the Northern Bullants.

In addition to the exposure gained on the day, the Club also donated one-quarter of the day's gate takings directly to the Whitehorse Community Chest Appeal.

### Epworth Eastern Hospital

Epworth Eastern, a major acute campus within the Epworth Healthcare Group, has been open since June 2005. The facility has 223 beds with a principle focus on Cardiac, Vascular, Orthopaedics, Oncology, Urology, Endoscopy and General Surgery. Epworth Eastern has state-of-the-art equipment, digital operating suites, a computerised medication administration system and best of all private rooms with caring medical staff.

At the prestigious Australian Private Hospitals Awards ceremony held on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2007, the programme beat a number of high quality nominees to receive a Major Award in the category of "Community Involvement".
