## Senior Coach's Report

For the third consecutive year, both the Box Hill Hawks Senior and Development Teams played off in their respective Grand Finals. Sadly, the results replicated those of 2014 with both teams suffering Grand Final defeats.

The Box Hill Hawks have set a high standard for a long time and in 2015 the Senior team qualified for the Finals for a seventh consecutive season, including finishing in the top four for the third year in a row. Boasting the second best attack and best defence in 2015; it paved a way for a 14 win / 4 loss record – claiming the minor Premiership and once again giving us the valuable double chance in Finals.

We overcame a slow start in our first final against last year's premiers Footscray to claim a 40 point win at Box Hill City Oval. On the back of a 5 goal haul from Dallas Willsmore and 38 disposal game from Jonathan Simpkin; the Hawks leap frogged into the third week of Finals.

We made a stronger start in the Preliminary Final; kicking 5.6 to 1.1 in the opening term before the fast-finishing Sandringham made their charge to bring the margin to 11 points at the final break.

James Sicily led the way with three goals with Marc Lock and Jed Anderson (two goals each) lively but it was Will Langford's goal in the dying stages to put the Hawks seven points ahead with just minutes remaining that ensured the Hawks advanced to the Grand Final for a third straight year.

We did a lot of things right in 2015, unfortunately the Grand Final was not one of them. We didn't meet those high standards and, with an uncharacteristic display in which we managed just 2 goals 10 behinds after half time, the Seagulls put the game beyond doubt as they booted the last six goals of the contest to register a 54 point win.

The lessons we will learn from this disappointing loss will no doubt help drive the club forward in 2016 but what we must also do is acknowledge that to be as consistent as we have been during the last few years means we're doing something right..... and we should take heart from that.

The unity between the Hawthorn and Box Hill Hawks Football Clubs is the best in the competition with players, staff, volunteers and family from both Clubs making invaluable contributions at training, game day and also socially – a clear demonstration of why we're able to continually reach such high standards.

It goes without saying that this Club would not function without this wonderful group of dedicated people. You all have a vital role to play at this Club and the work that you do never goes unnoticed and is truly appreciated.
