General Manager's Report

V.F.L./W. Football Operations

I would like to start by congratulating all the players, coaches, staff and volunteers right across our Club for their efforts this season. Each year we set our sights on a top 4 finish in both our V.F.L. and V.F.L.W. programs, a feat we managed to achieve in a highly competitive season. We welcomed the V.F.L.W. program back under the Box Hill Hawks banner for the first time since 2017, making the Club feel whole again.

The V.F.L.W. season was particularly tight with just two wins separating first and ninth on the ladder. The Hawks finished the home and away season in fourth place with eight wins, four losses and two draws. Had we managed to win one of those draws, we would have finished top and earned a double chance. Unfortunately, we went down in the Elimination Final to old foe, Essendon.

The V.F.L. story was slightly different, with Box Hill spending most of the season in the top four behind powerhouse sides Gold Coast and Werribee. A third-place finish came finals time with a fourteen wins / four losses record setting up a Qualifying Final against Werribee on their home turf. A hotly contested match from start to finish with Werribee playing their small ground perfectly to come out on top. That sent us back to City Oval for a home Semi-Final against the Bulldogs, who were on an 11-game winning streak, a streak that ended that day to the tune of 20 points in what was one of the season highlights. So, a Preliminary Final against the flag favourites, Gold Coast at Gold Coast. The toughest road trip in the V.F.L. It was a very even game for the most part, Gold Coast taking a minor lead at every break. The Hawks managed to cut the margin to five points in the final quarter, but the Suns class rose to the top and the eventual Premiers ran out victors by 15 points.

To Zane Littlejohn and Cherie O'Neill, thank you for building and setting a great culture that people want to be a part of. The time and dedication it takes to run high quality V.F.L./W. programs should not be underestimated and the quality of our programs is testament to your hard work and will to succeed. Thanks also to our V.F.L. coaching group, Cam Howat, Kristian Height, Clayton Sturzaker, Damien Mascitti and Andy Collins, as well as V.F.L.W. coaches Hayley Gregory, Alex McKenzie, Ross Gemmill.

Our Development program lead by David Banfield with support from Kade Pargeter and Jason Philactides saw many Eastern Ranges and Gippsland Power graduates participate throughout the year, and the off-field development of our under 22 players through our Spread Your Wings program helped to set these young people up for success in their life away from Football.

To our playing group, led by Captains Hugh Beasley, Cal Porter and Nicole Garner, you all continue to set the benchmark high and drive the standards of this football club, creating an environment that is fun, safe and inclusive which people feel comfortable to challenge and be challenged.

Keeping our players in peak physical condition takes an army, led by our High Performance Managers, Dylan Vizzarri (V.F.L.) and Josh Holding (V.F.L.W.). The programs were well supported by the Physio team James Serong, Charlie Logan, Bill Williams, Clare O'Dwyer, Jemma Catt, Dani Juraga, Emily Purvis and Nicola Hanley. V.F.L. Senior Coach's Report

I heard a lot of great things about the Alignment coming into the role, and all of those were true. The commitment of both Clubs to the alignment is first-class and something they should be really proud of. One thing that stood out to me was the connection the players built together, particularly over the finals. Hopefully the boys have made some friendships for life now, not just for a footy season. The relationship that Sam Mitchell and I developed, and the mentorship from him, Andy Collins and all the assistant coaches has been great. Their support allowed me to make sure I could execute and coach the game plan the way we needed it to be performed.

Finishing top four was a great outcome. Beating Footscray was the first final many of our players have ever won in their senior footy careers. To then travel interstate to take on the Gold Coast Suns – the eventual 2023 premiers winners – and just lose by 15 points on their home deck was a spirited effort.

The semi-final win over the Bulldogs was a highlight. I remember being in the changerooms with so many Box Hill Hawks supporters. It was great to see their smiles as much as it was to see the players smiles. I'm glad the players got to experience what winning a final was like and now can understand the growth we've got to continue to do to ideally go all the way in future years. Another highlight was in Round One when we beat Sydney on the road – my first win as coach. To see the players' connection and their ability to buy in was great. That win gave every player, whether they played or not, a real confidence that the program and alignment was going to continue to be really strong, even with a new coach. It gave me a lot of confidence too.

We lost three key players before the season started with Ben Cavarra, Benny De Bolfo, and James Parsons all doing ACLs. We thought we would lose a bit of depth, but our Box Hill guys really stood up. It was the healthiest year the program has had in the alignment regarding to AFL availability, we averaged 15 A.F.L. players per game this year. That's a full credit to High Performance Manager Peter Burge and Hawthorn's medical team. We've created an environment where the players want to make sure they can perform and play well both at Box Hill and Hawthorn. We played 52 players this year, with 32 A.F.L. and 20 Box Hill listed players. Two players, Cal Porter and Ed Phillips, played every game. Rookie Josh Bennetts, who finished as Box Hill's Best First Year Player, played every game but one. It was a really challenging year for the match committee, we averaged five to six changes a week and our preliminary final was the only game all year when we went in unchanged.

We wanted to make sure that we harnessed an exciting brand of footy, similar to what Hawthorn are trying to play at A.F.L. level. Our ball movement was one of the key areas we were able to show over the year. We finished top two for our ability to transition the ball from our defensive 50 to our forward 50. We were also one of the highest scoring teams for the year, which was pleasing. Our program is about development, but also winning as well. We want to teach our players how to win and what that looks and feels like. That's why game plan similarities are really important.

Three of our guys made A.F.L. lists this year – Clay Tucker (Hawthorn), Ethan Stanley (Fremantle) and Ryan Maric (West Coast). That was a great reward and something we're really proud of. Box Hill and Hawthorn continually provide a program not just to develop the Hawthorn players, but also the players within the community and zoned areas as well which is fantastic. V.F.L.W. Report

Highlights of the V.F.L.W. season included the team's first win against the Western Bulldogs at Box Hill City Oval in Round Two. It was a seesawing contest in tough conditions with the Hawks getting up by one point.

The next memorable game came in Round Six when the Hawks made history and played their first ever V.F.L.W. game at Wonthaggi Recreation Reserve. Debutant Hannah Fosbrooke got the crowd on their feet with two majors on debut to lead her side to a 33-point victory. Boyd had a monster game after missing the previous two rounds, recording 22 disposals, 10 hit-outs, taking eight marks and kicking a goal.

The game of the year came in Round Nine when the Hawks secured a thrilling one-point win over Carlton. This match was significant for reasons beyond the four points, as it marked Gabby Collingwood's return from back-to-back ACL injuries while playing for Brisbane's A.F.L.W. team. Not only did she get through the game unscathed, but she kicked the match-winning goal after the siren, getting the Box Hill crowd up on their feet and sparking memorable celebrations.

The Hawks faced their fair share of adversity to overcome throughout the season, with two draws against Essendon and Geelong. It was the Bombers who would then end Box Hill's season in an elimination final, suffering a 10-point loss on home soil.

From an individual point of view, Jordan Mifsud had a season to remember, taking home the league's Lambert-Pearce Medal alongside teammate Akayla Peterson as well as Box Hill's V.F.L.W. Best and Fairest Award. Mifsud was closely followed by Grace McRae and Matilda Van Berkel in the count, with Van Berkel also taking home the club's Best First Year Player Award. Midfielder Annie Muir won the Development Award, utility Amanda Tessari was named Best Clubperson, captain Nicole Garner was Best In Finals while Boyd and Miz Kendall took out the Club's Goalkicking Award.

As with every post-season, there has been some unfortunate departures from the Club. Former Hawks V.F.L.W. Captain Jess Trend announced that the 2023 season would be her last in the V.F.L.W. After coming across to the Hawks in 2021, the 32-year-old notched up her 100th V.W.F.L./V.F.L.W. appearance and made a long-lasting impact on the team with her energy and experience in the league. Trend was joined on the way out by coach Cherie O'Neill, who decided she would pursue other opportunities.

O'Neill left a lasting legacy on the Hawks after taking the team to two finals campaigns and seeing nineteen players get drafted to the A.F.L.W. from her program.

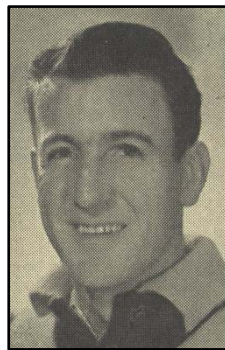

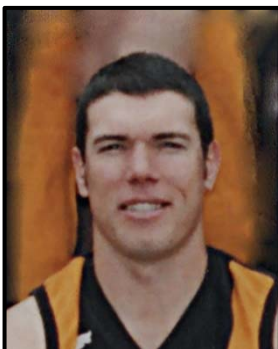

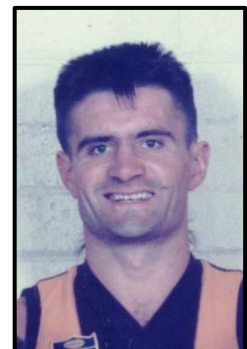
