

#### President's Premiership Report

2001 - what a great year - a truly memorable season.

Firstly, I would like to congratulate Donald McDonald and his team for their outstanding achievements throughout the entire season, particularly on Grand Final day. As President, one of the things that has impressed me so much this year is the camaraderie and spirit that exists so evidently amongst the players.

I would like to particularly congratulate the Box Hill listed players, not just the ones who were lucky enough to play in the Grand Final, but everyone who wore the Box Hill jumper this year. Our Reserves, who were unluckily defeated in their first Final, provided a wonderful platform upon which our Seniors were able to build. The attitude and vigour with which they attacked their task put constant pressure on the Seniors players to perform. I think we all know how important that is and it certainly is a testament to the work Ian Wilson has done in coaching the Reserves this season. Thank you also to the parents of our players who play such an important support role to their sons during the ups and downs of a Football season.

And of course, I would like to acknowledge the efforts of Box Hill General Manager Luke Jervis and his able assistant Libby Bowen. Both their contributions have been outstanding and I thank both for their support and assistance to the Box Hill Hawks Board in running the Football Club.

A particular thank you to John Hook, the Business Operations Manager from Hawthorn Football Club, for his assistance this year. John has been a wonderful link between Hawthorn and Box Hill and his experience in Football Administration has been invaluable. Thank you also to Michael Brown, the C.E.O. of Hawthorn Football Club, Peter Schwab, David Parkin and all the Match Committee and staff who have contributed to our success this year.

A special thank you also to all the support staff trainers, runners, drink attendants, score board attendants, statisticians, time-keeping personnel, catering staff and people like Brian McMahon and Don Cairns who clean up the mess at the ground after each match. There are too many names to mention individually but rest assured your contribution is greatly appreciated and all of you have played an integral role in winning a Premiership.

Finally, I would like to thank the Board of Directors of the Box Hill Hawks for the support they have given the Club this year. Our monthly Board meetings are often a place of spirited discussion and debate. However, it is terrific for the Club to have the support of a group of people so committed and all working towards a common goal.

Once again, congratulations to the 2001 V.F.L. Premiers, the MIGHTY BOX HILL HAWKS.

#### **Finance Report**

To have been a part of Box Hill's first Major Division V.F.A./V.F.L. Premiership is certainly a great honour and I congratulate everyone involved.

2001 marked the first year of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated's operations entirely in a support role to the Box Hill Hawks following the restructuring of the Club's finances and the discharging of all the Club's debts prior to the 2000 season. The Committees of the Box Hill Football Club and our associated groups have continued to operate strongly during the year, producing \$52,197 of income for the Box Hill Hawks from their various activities. The Club incurred minimal expenses during the year; the final trading result was a retained operating deficit of \$4,660, the small negative result being entirely due to depreciation charges against the Club's assets.

The major activities of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated and its associated groups during the year were the sale of Memberships and the management of the Club's Social Club and Bingo operations. Detailed below is a brief overview of their results.

#### Membership

Membership of the Box Hill Football Club totalled 230 persons in 2001, comprising 74 Life Members, 86 Financial Members of the Box Hill Football Club, 47 Financial Members of the Box Hill Football Club Past Players and Officials Association and 23 Financial Members of the Box Hill Football Club Social Club. This figure confirmed the most disturbing fall in Box Hill Football Club Membership since the alignment with Hawthorn, as evidenced by the Club's Membership numbers in 1999 (379) and 2000 (268).

Correspondingly, overall Membership revenue was down from \$7,890 in 2000 to \$5,750 during the year past. It would seem that, for the time being at least, the Club must rely on the majority of its support from Hawthorn's Membership base and that only a fraction of the Club's following is from people without a direct Hawthorn interest. Strategies must be developed as a priority to win back disaffected Box Hill supporters and to attract people to follow Box Hill as a Football Club in it's own right in order to reinvigorated the Club's Membership numbers.

#### Bingo

Net after-G.S.T. Bingo revenue during the year was \$46,447, an improvement over the \$37,592 raised during 2000 and more than double the income raised during the low-point in 1999. It is worthwhile recording that the G.S.T. liability incurred by the Club's Bingo sessions was \$4,790; this is a tax that is a direct impost on the fundraising of many community groups such as ours and on that basis alone must be described as extremely unfair.

A restructuring of operations was performed just prior to Christmas last year, a most successful exercise as most sessions have consistently generating some income since. Recent months give cause for optimism that the worst of the Bingo downturn is over, however, many years of involvement with this often fickle income source make me disinclined to make any rash predictions to our Members. Once again, to the Management of the Box Hill Bingo Centre and our loyal band of Bingo workers, we express our sincere gratitude for keeping viable this vital income source.

#### Social Club

The Committee of the Box Hill Football Club Social Club was again responsible for the operation of the Social Rooms and for conducting Bingo sessions at Box Hill Central Bingo Centre during the course of the year. Match day bar patronage was comparable with 2000 (average attendance during 2000 was 1,761 and during 2001 was 1,893) and overall revenue benefited greatly from the V.A.F.A. Finals hosted at City Oval and the Grand Final after-match celebrations.

#### The Future

The Box Hill Football Club in its present guise is financially stable, but the Box Hill Hawks faces considerable challenges to achieve financial security. For the first two years of its existence the Box Hill Hawks has relied partially on V.F.L. subsidy; from 2002 this contribution is no longer available. In this regard the Box Hill Football Club has a vital role to play by maximising existing income sources and working towards establishing additional revenue streams. The support of all our Members is required to enable the Box Hill Hawks to continue as a strong Club, achieving on-field success in a similar fashion to this year in which we can all take much pride.

#### Senior Coach's Report

How do you define tradition and culture when it comes to Football Clubs? Is it derived from the success of that particular club or is it from the people involved in a variety of ways that create the tradition or culture. It is something that has always fascinated me and when I was appointed coach of the Box Hill Hawks I tried to define where I thought Box Hill was at. This Club has not had the success of other Clubs however I respected the Club for being a survivor so therefor the people involved over the journey have successfully played there part in laying a foundation. This year we were fortunate enough to add to that foundation with some on field success only as a result of what has gone on previously to this year. Hopefully the people who have been involved with Box Hill Football Club over the past 51 years really derived some satisfaction from this year's success.

Obviously the make-up of our Club is different from what it used to be as we are in a different competition. We still wear the colours and we still are called Box Hill, we still play at City Oval, the only differences are positive ones. We have more supporters, we have better facilities and we have access to A.F.L. Footballers. Our philosophy for our Box Hill list is that we want to recruit players who have their best football ahead of them the only exceptions to that would be if we felt we were too inexperienced. Then it would be a matter of recruiting not only a quality experienced A.F.L. player but more importantly a quality person.

This year the players from our Box Hill list did very well. The attitudes of the players in relation to their individual preparations was first class. We could have up to five players either drafted or Rookie listed and the continued development from the majority of our list was very evident to those who followed us closely throughout the year. We had seven Box Hill listed players in our Grand Final side and our Reserves finished the season in third place on the ladder only to suffer a one point defeat in their first Final and be eliminated.

Next year we need to keep the standard up by reinforcing our philosophy at Box Hill and help create an environment in which everybody understands what we are about and where we are heading. Our goal will be to do the best we can and to continue to compete in an aggressive fashion. It promises to be an exciting year with the continued ground redevelopments, support of the council and further growth in our own supporter base. It will be an opportunity to build on this years success. Personally I want to thank everybody for their continued support and I look forward to seeing you all in the not too distant future. Go the Mighty Box Hill Hawks!

The year was the second year of the association's three-year agreement with the Hawthorn Football Club Ltd to operate the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, a joint venture company established to field teams in Victorian Football League and to pursue the aims and objectives of both organisations. Under the terms of the agreement, the association appoints three of the six members and four of the ten directors of the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These appointments are made in accordance with the Rules of the association.

#### RESULTS

The operating profit for the period was \$47,537. An appropriation of \$52,197 was made to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, resulting in a retained operating deficit of \$4,660 (2000 result: \$226,152 operating profit including extraordinary income; \$47,495 appropriation to Box Hill Hawks Ltd; \$178,657 retained operating surplus).

#### DIVIDENDS

The Club is an incorporated association and is not permitted under its Rules to make any distributions to its members.

#### REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

As part of the agreement entered into by the association to form the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, and as a fifty percent partner in the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, the association continued to operate its Social Club and Bingo operations during the year in furtherance of its aims and objectives and appropriated profit from these operations to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These factors resulted in a small retained operating deficit and a slight reduction in the surplus of assets over liabilities at balance date.

#### SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

There was no significant change in the operations of the association during the period.

#### **EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO BALANCE DATE**

There has not arisen during the interval between the end of this financial period and the date of this report any item, transaction or event of a material or unusual nature likely in the opinion of the Board of Management of the association to affect substantially the results of the association for the next succeeding financial period.

#### LIKELY DEVELOPMENTS

No information is included on the likely developments in the operations of the association and the expected results of the association as it is in the opinion of the Board of Management of the association that this information would prejudice the interests of the association if it were included in this report.

#### **BOARD OF MANAGEMENTS' BENEFITS**

Since the end of the previous financial period, no member of the Board of Management of association has received or become entitled to receive a benefit (other than a benefit included in the aggregate amount of emoluments received or due and receivable by the directors shown in the accounts) by reason of a contract made by the association or by a related corporation with the member of the Board of Management or with a firm of which he is a member, or with a company in which he has a substantial financial interest.
