Thanks must be also extended to Ian Dicker, the President of the Hawthorn Football Club, and to Michael Brown, the Hawthorn Chief Executive. Both these gentlemen have been instrumental in the establishment and guidance of the Hawthorn - Box Hill alliance during its first three years and their support is appreciated by all at the Club.

Also, I would like to thank the Board of Directors of the Box Hill Hawks for the support that they have given both to me personally and to the Club during the year. Our monthly Board meetings are always spirited and productive and it is terrific to have such a dedicated group of people all working towards a common goal.

A special mention of our first year General Manager, Andrew Pirchan. Andrew came to us late last year more familiar with the "round ball" game than ours. However, his enthusiasm to learn about what the role required has been exceptional and his efforts in marketing the Club have achieved excellent results this year and laid a sound foundation for ongoing success.

To our dedicated team of support staff, trainers, physiotherapists and volunteers - thank you. The Club cannot function without your help and the Board appreciates the long hours you all put in to make the Box Hill Hawks the professional organisation that it now is. Firstly, our coach Donald McDonald this year became only the second Coach ever in 125 years of V.F.A./V.F.L. history to coach 200 Senior matches. Donald's commitment to and passion for the Box Hill Hawks has been second-to-none and we wish him all the best in the future as he meets new challenges as an assistant coach at Hawthorn.

Secondly, Michael Firrito won the Fothergill-Round Medal as the V.F.L.'s 2002 Young Player of the Year. Michael has certainly had a fine year and his success typifies the Club's commitment to promoting and developing young, talented players. Well done Michael!

Last, but by no means least, how will we ever forget the amazing feat of our favourite son Sam Mitchell who defied all odds to comfortably claim the V.F.L.'s prestigious J.J. Liston medal with ten best-on-the ground performances from only eleven games under his belt? This was the first time in over forty years (and only the third time in history) that a Box Hill player has achieved this award, so congratulations Sam on a most memorable triumph.

On a more sombre note, the Club was deeply saddened by the passing of three stalwarts during the year - Ron Gibbs, Reg Shineberg and Edna Wilson. The death of these Mustang legends reminds us how fragile the links are with the Club's momentous past and the sympathy of all associated with the Box Hill Hawks is extended to the families concerned.

On a final note, I would like to thank each and every one of you for making my Presidency over the last three years as memorable as it was. You may or may not be aware that, due to work commitments, I have had to relocate to Sydney which means that I have had to relinquish my position as Club President.

However, before long we will have a new President, new Coach and a fresh new attitude for 2003. I will follow the Club's progress with much interest. Go the Mighty Box Hill Hawks!

It is pleasing to report on the strong performance of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated's operations during the 2002 Financial Year. Income generated for the Box Hill Hawks increased by some fifty percent, from \$52,197 in 2001 to \$78,313 during the year past. The Club incurred minimal expenses during the year; the final trading result was a retained operating deficit of \$8,787, due mainly to depreciation charges against the Club's fixed assets.

The major activities of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated and its associated groups during the year were the sale of Memberships and the management of the Club's Social Club and Bingo operations. Detailed below is a brief overview of their results.

Bingo

Net after-G.S.T. Bingo revenue during the year was \$68,222, a significant improvement over the \$46,447 generated during 2001 Our sessions performed particularly strongly during the early months of 2002 but have tapered-off somewhat in recent times, with the introduction of the smoking ban in gaming venues on 1st September, 2002 having a significant effect on patronage. Hopefully, this effect will be only temporary as has been experienced in other public venues when smoking bans have been first introduced.

Bingo these days is a most uncertain income source, being seemingly effected on a weekly basis by a myriad of external influences beyond our control. Our sincere thanks is extended to our loyal band of Bingo workers, in particular Jim Dowling, for their hard work on behalf of the Club. To Denis Corless and the Management of the Box Hill Bingo Centre, we are again most grateful for your on-going support of our Club.

Membership

Membership of the Box Hill Football Club totalled 304 persons in 2002, comprising 73 Life Members, 183 Financial Members of the Box Hill Football Club and 48 Financial Members of the Box Hill Football Club Past Players and Officials Association. This represented the first year since the establishment of the Box Hill Hawks that Membership numbers had actually increased compared with the previous year (total Membership for 2001 - 230) and there was a corresponding increase in Membership revenue, from \$5,750 in 2001 to \$10,091 in 2002.

No doubt the increase in Membership numbers can be partly attributed to the Club's Premiership success in 2001. Hopefully, it is also due in some way to a return of the Club's traditional supporter as a greater acceptance and understanding is developed of the new V.F.L. competition structure and the role of the Box Hill Hawks through its alignment with Hawthorn.

Social Club

The Committee of the Box Hill Football Club Social Club was again responsible for the operation of the Social Rooms and for conducting Bingo sessions at Box Hill Central Bingo Centre during the course of the year. Regrettably, it was found necessary to out-source some of the match day operations as insufficient volunteers were able to be found to cater for the larger crowds enjoyed these days. Home-and-away attendances decreased slightly, from an average attendance of 1,893 in 2001 to 1,704 in 2002, however the shortfall in match day revenue was offset by income from the first-ever V.F.L. Final played at City Oval and the V.A.F.A. Finals which we again successfully hosted.

The Future

It is pleasing to report that the Box Hill Hawks recorded a break-even trading result in 2002, even more so given that this was achieved without the benefit of V.F.L. subsidy that the Box Hill Hawks enjoyed during the first two years of its operation. The Members of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated can take pleasure from our Club's strong contribution to the Box Hill Hawk's pleasing financial result and the sound financial position of our Club these days. Our ongoing challenges are to maximise existing income sources and to work towards establishing additional revenue streams. The support of all our Members is required achieve these goals.

Membership numbers were virtually static compared with the previous year, increasing by one from 47 in 2001 to 48 in 2002. Our activities included producing two editions of our official newsletter, "Mustang Memories", and we hosted a match day luncheon at the Box Hill Hawks vs Sandringham game. This was our most successful match day function yet with over fifty past players and officials in attendance and all eras of the Club's history represented.

I would like to acknowledge the support of Association Members such as David Banfield, Ian Bates, Kevin Collins, John Cromb, Garry Ireland, Trevor La Roche and John Ure who all worked very hard and successfully to encourage other past players and officials to participate in our official activities.

V.F.L. Medallists

J.J. Liston Medal

Sam Mitchell of the Box Hill Hawks won the 2002 J.J. Liston Medal as the Best and Fairest Player in the V.F.L., the first Box Hill player to win this award since Doug Beasy in 1961. In possibly the most outstanding effort ever by a winner of the J.J. Liston Medal, Sam only played eleven games with the Box Hill Hawks, polling ten best-on-ground votes and one third vote to be a clear winner.

Sam was drafted by Hawthorn from the Box Hill Hawks in the 2002 pre-season draft and his sensational form with the Box Hill Hawks was rewarded with nine A.F.L. games during the 2002 season. He is a wonderful talent who seems certain to have a long and successful A.F.L. career ahead of him.

Fothergill-Round Medal

Michael Firrito of the Box Hill Hawks won the 2002 Fothergill-Round Medal, awarded by the Board of Directors of Football Victoria to the most outstanding young talent in the V.F.L.

Michael was recruited by the Box Hill Hawks from the the Eastern Ranges, where he won the 2001 Best and Fairest Award. His excellent form during the 2002 season resulted in 19 Senior games and he was awarded the Club's Best First Year Player Trophy.

V.F.L. Representation

The Box Hill Football Club's congratulations are extended to Matthew Brewer and Mark Passador of the Box Hill Hawks who represented the Club with distinction in the V.F.L.'s fifty-six point defeat of the S.A.N.F.L. in the interstate game played at the Adelaide Oval on 15th June, 2002.

Vale Ron Gibbs

All associated with the Box Hill Football Club were deeply shocked and saddened by the sudden death of Club stalwart Ron Gibbs on 30th June, 2002 at the age of 83. Ron was an institution at the Club who exemplified in every way the Mustang spirit. How many Clubs could boast that it had a member of the Committee who had served continuously for sixty-five years since the Club was founded in 1936?

Ron Gibbs attended the meeting at which the Box Hill Football Club was formed in late 1936 and was one of the thirty people who paid the subscription to become foundation members of the Club. At the same meeting, he joined the Club's first ever Committee as an eighteen year old. The remarkable statistics of his contribution to the Box Hill Football Club since that date include twenty-two years as Vice-President, twenty-one years as ground manager, Membership secretary for twenty-five years and gate-keeper for over thirty years.

Not surprisingly, Ron Gibbs received many honours for his unsurpassed service to the Box Hill Football Club. The Club honoured him with Life Membership for "long and meritorious service" in 1954. He still had an incredible forty-eight years of contribution to the Club ahead of him. He also was a Life Member of the V.F.A. Under 19s and received Life Membership of the Victorian Football Association (now Victorian Football League) in 1991.

Ron was renown as the world champion raffle ticket seller. He often said that his secret was simple; he was just nice to people, and once you managed to engage a passer-by in a conversation they were almost certain to buy a ticket from you.

Such was his devotion to his work for the Club that two years ago he declined an invitation to nominate the best Box Hill players he had ever seen. He stated that in over fifty years he had never actually sat down and watched a Box Hill game, being too busy with his various duties on match days. His commitment to the Box Hill Football Club never wavered. The day before he passed away he was doing what he enjoyed best, selling raffle tickets for the Club.

Ron's wife Barbara shared his passion for the Box Hill Football Club, joining the committee in 1951. In 1993 they reached the unprecedented milestone of one hundred years of combined committee work for the Club. Ron and Barbara's long and happy marriage produced three children; Alan, Lorraine and Graham. He was a devoted father and later a much loved Poppy to his five grandchildren and six great grandchildren.

Ron Gibbs spent nearly all his spare time helping others and will be always remembered for his honesty, good humour and his ready smile for his many friends. His passing leaves a huge hole at the Box Hill Football Club that will be impossible to fill.

PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The principal activities of the association were the management and promotion of an Australian Rules Football Club affiliated with the Victorian Football League. The year was the third and final year of the association's three-year agreement with the Hawthorn Football Club Ltd to operate the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, a joint venture company established to field teams in Victorian Football League and to pursue the aims and objectives of both organisations. Under the terms of the agreement, the association appoints three of the six members and four of the ten directors of the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These appointments are made in accordance with the Rules of the association.

RESULTS

The operating profit for the period was \$69,526. An appropriation of \$78,313 was made to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, resulting in a retained operating deficit of \$8,787 (2001 result: \$47,537 operating profit; \$52,197 appropriation to Box Hill Hawks Ltd; \$4,660 retained operating deficit).

DIVIDENDS

The Club is an incorporated association and is not permitted under its Rules to make any distributions to its members.

REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

As part of the agreement entered into by the association to form the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, and as a fifty percent partner in the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, the association continued to operate its Social Club and Bingo operations during the year in furtherance of its aims and objectives and appropriated profit from these operations to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These factors resulted in a small retained operating deficit and a slight reduction in the surplus of assets over liabilities at balance date.

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

There was no significant change in the operations of the association during the period.

EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO BALANCE DATE

There has not arisen during the interval between the end of this financial period and the date of this report any item, transaction or event of a material or unusual nature likely in the opinion of the Board of Management of the association to affect substantially the results of the association for the next succeeding financial period.

LIKELY DEVELOPMENTS

No information is included on the likely developments in the operations of the association and the expected results of the association as it is in the opinion of the Board of Management of the association that this information would prejudice the interests of the association if it were included in this report.

BOARD OF MANAGEMENTS' BENEFITS

Since the end of the previous financial period, no member of the Board of Management of association has received or become entitled to receive a benefit (other than a benefit included in the aggregate amount of emoluments received or due and receivable by the directors shown in the accounts) by reason of a contract made by the association or by a related corporation with the member of the Board of Management or with a firm of which he is a member, or with a company in which he has a substantial financial interest.
