President's Report

It is a pleasure to reflect on my first year as President of the Box Hill Hawks. All in all, with our Senior team competing in the V.F.L. Grand Final for the second time in three seasons, 2003 was a year of fine achievement.

Despite our on-field success in recent years, the Club finished the 2002 season somewhat at the crossroads. For the first time since our alignment with Hawthorn, there was significant change off the field. Employment took our President, Tony Pinwill, to Sydney. Our Senior Coach, Donald McDonald, was rightly rewarded for his great success in the V.F.A./V.F.L. for a decade by being appointed by Hawthorn as a full-time assistant A.F.L. coach.

It is right that I acknowledge the outstanding contribution of Tony Pinwill to the Box Hill Hawks during his three years as President. My decision to accept the Presidency was made much easier by the knowledge that previous incumbent had left the Club in such a sound position on and off the field.

The high quality of applicants for the Senior Coaching position reflected the vast improvement in the prestige and status that our Club and the V.F.L. competition have experienced in recent years. I do not think that one person associated with the Box Hill Hawks was anything less than genuinely excited when Tony Liberatore was appointed as our Senior Coach. Tony brought with him a wonderful record following a seventeen year V.F.L./A.F.L. career that brought him much honour, including a Brownlow Medal. A proven leader on the field, but very much a novice coach, we hoped that he could instil his own brand of determination and commitment into the performances of the Box Hill Hawks.

The pre-season period was one of uncertainty. The departure of Mark Passador to play in the S.A.N.F.L., the loss of Clinton Alleway and Michael Firrito, who were both Rookie-listed by the Kangaroos, and the unexpected retirements of Captain Matthew Brewer and experienced defender Matthew Banks after completing the pre-season left us with a young and inexperienced list. On the positive side was the return of Andrew Pugsley after a year travelling overseas, the recruitment of ex-Kangaroo Stuart Anderson, the signing of Matthew Ball and Michael Georgiadis after being delisted by Hawthorn and the arrival of Stephen Kenna from Mt Gravatt in the Q.A.F.L., following the same path as Clinton Alleway before him to advance his Football career.

In addition, our recruitment from our traditional breeding ground, the Eastern Ranges, was not as fruitful as in previous years. This was due to Eastern having eight players drafted to the A.F.L. following their stellar Premiership year in 2002. When our list was finalised, it was generally felt that the depth of talent was not of the same order as in previous seasons.

Practice match form was mixed and a disappointing loss in the opening Round of the home and away season to Frankston seemed to confirm the view of the pundits that the Box Hill Hawks could, at best, expect to finish in the lower echelon of the Final Eight. Our Club has made a habit of proving the so-called experts to be wrong over the years and 2003 proved to be no exception.

The year produced many on-field highlights, but for my mind three stick out. For nearly four months, from 13th April to 27th July, we were undefeated, achieving an all time Club record of thirteen consecutive victories. Included in this magnificent run were come from behind away ground wins at Port Melbourne, Springvale and Williamstown; which must be a very rare treble indeed against these three V.F.L. powerhouses.

Secondly, as a Club we celebrated Box Hill's 1000th V.F.A./V.F.L. game in the Qualifying Final against Williamstown, in our 53rd season since joining the V.F.A. in 1951. While we lowered our colours on the day, it was a wonderful occasion in which we appropriately acknowledged our Club's long and proud history. I will never forget the sight of our players running onto City Oval wearing replicas of the jumpers that Box Hill wore when it played its first V.F.A. game all those years ago.

Finally, in our 1001st game, the Box Hill Hawks pulled off one of the greatest wins in the Club's history, storming back from 50 points down half way through the third quarter to defeat Werribee by a solitary point with a goal kicked virtually on the final siren. While Box Hill teams have overcome larger deficits in the past to win games of Football, this victory was achieved under the pressure of a knock out Final with the entire season on the line, and enabled us to play in a Grand Final two weeks later. It was an unforgettable performance and I doubt if a Box Hill team has ever dug deeper to produce a victory against all odds.

In the final analysis we deservedly won our way into the Grand Final to be confronted by our old foes Williamstown, bristling with A.F.L. talent due to unrestricted access to Collingwood players who were not playing in the Magpies' A.F.L. Finals campaign. The realists amongst us knew that we faced an enormous challenge and our worst fears were realised when Williamstown jumped us, leading by 46 points at half time. Our players fought gallantly and I believe that we were comfortably the better team in the second half, but too great a start had been given to a quality team. I congratulate the Williamstown Football Club which fully deserved its 29 point victory on Grand Final day.

Congratulations to our Senior Coach, Tony Liberatore, Reserves Coach, Frank Lesiputty, and the entire Match Committee for their achievements this year. Frank was unable to lift our young Reserves team into the Finals, but they were most competitive against all teams and I believe we will reap the rewards of his efforts in 2004 as many of these young players mature.



I congratulate our talented band of players for their achievements this year, in particular our trophy winners, those that reached 50 game milestones and those that represented the Club on Grand Final day. Particular mention is made of our Club Champion, Matthew Ball, and Best First Year Player, Stephen Kenna, who were selected by Hawthorn and Carlton respectively in the November Draft. This makes a total of seven Box Hill Hawks players to have been elevated to either A.F.L. Senior or Rookie Lists in the past four years, easily the most from any V.F.L. Club. I believe that we should be just as proud of this achievement as our on-field V.F.L. success during the same period. Ryan Cassidy also brought honour to our Club by winning the A. Todd Medal as the Best and Fairest player in the V.F.L. Reserve Grade Competition.

Thank you to the Board of Directors of the Box Hill Hawks for their sound management of the Club during the season. My role as President is made easy by the support of a united Board representing both the Box Hill and Hawthorn sides of the alignment all working towards a common goal. Particular mention is made of Brien McMahon who continued to contribute strongly under very difficult personal circumstances.

I acknowledge the tremendous support that our Club has again received from our A.F.L. partner. The Box Hill Hawks - Hawthorn alignment is generally regarded as the model for other Clubs to follow. Particular thanks are due to the President of the Hawthorn Football Club, Mr. Ian Dicker, the Chief Executive, Mr. Steven Leighton and the General Manager of Football Operations, Mr. John Hook, for the active interest that they take in our Club.

Special mention to the General Manager of the Box Hill Hawks, Andrew Pirchan, and his assistant, Bob Lyford. Five years ago we would not have dared to even dream about the sort of results that Andrew has achieved marketing our Club. Both Andrew and Bob have worked very hard and very professionally to ensure that the Box Hill Hawks is financially sound, as well as being a successful Club.

To all our sponsors, we thank you for your contribution and support. We hope that your business has benefited from your involvement with the Box Hill Hawks and, just as importantly, that you have enjoyed being associated with our Club.

To our loyal and dedicated team of support staff and volunteers, a sincere thank you. You are the heart and soul of our Club and we would not be able to function without you. We are going to very much miss Jim Dowling who, after nearly twenty years of involvement with the Club as our Bingo Manager and Team Manager, has moved to Merimbula with his wife Beryl to escape Melbourne's cold winters. I think we are all envious of their lifestyle change but we will greatly miss Jim's friendly presence and help around the Club.

Finally, I thank the Members of the Box Hill Football Club and the Directors of the Box Hill Hawks for granting me the privilege of serving as President of this great Club. As you know, I have been involved with Box Hill for many years, and this year has been one of the most enjoyable of all. Let's hope that we can go onto further success, and maybe even one better, in 2004.

Finance Report

The operations of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated once again made an important contribution to the financial operations of the Box Hill Hawks, although profit appropriated to this entity decreased from \$78,313 in 2002 to \$35,675 during the year past. The Club again incurred minimal trading expenses during the year; final trading result was a retained operating deficit of \$3,532 due mainly to depreciation charges against the Club's fixed assets.

Bingo, Social Club and the sale of Memberships are the main operations which remain under the auspices of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated and its associated groups. Detailed below is a brief overview of these results.

Bingo

Net after-GST revenue from Bingo decreased from \$68,222 in 2002 to \$30,589 in 2003. Anti-smoking legislation introduced for all gaming venues on 1st September, 2002 has had a marked effect on patronage in all areas of gaming throughout Victoria and the Box Hill Central Bingo Centre and consequentially our Club has not been spared in this regard. Returns have improved of recent times due again to another legislative change, this time effective from 1st October, 2003, which effectively guarantees Bingo permit holders a minimum profit from every session conducted.

Our sincere thanks is again extended to our loyal band of Bingo volunteers and the long contribution of our retiring Bingo Manager, Jim Dowling, is acknowledged with heartfelt thanks. To the Management of the Box Hill Central Bingo Centre, Denis Corless and Deborah Kearns, thank you again for your on-going support of our Club during tough times for the Bingo industry.

Membership

Membership of the Box Hill Football Club totalled 193 persons in 2003, comprising 71 Life Members, 88 Financial Members of the Box Hill Football Club and 34 Members of the Box Hill Football Club Past Players and Officials Association. This was a significant drop in the overall Membership figure of 304 achieved during 2002 and Membership revenue virtually halved from \$10,091 in 2002 to \$5,086 in 2003.



Social Club

After being forced to out-source staffing of the Social Rooms last year, happily a new band of enthusiastic volunteers enabled the Club to resume the responsibility for the operation of the Social Rooms in 2003. The extra burden levelled onto the administration of the Box Hill Hawks was a concern but this was offset somewhat by the vastly improved social atmosphere and financial returns achieved by the Social Club.

Improved V.F.L. home and away crowds at City Oval (from an average attendance of 1,704 in 2002 to 1,752 in 2003) coupled with the hosting of a well-attended V.F.L. Final and a series of most successful E.F.L. Finals ensured a significant boost in income from the Social Club.

Our thanks is extended to the Committee of the Box Hill Football Club Social Club who, as well as being responsible for the operation of the Social Rooms, conducted Bingo sessions at the Box Hill Central Bingo Centre during the course of the year.

The Future

It is pleasing to report that the Box Hill Hawks Ltd recorded its first trading profit in 2003 during its fourth year of operation as a joint venture between the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated and the Hawthorn Football Club Ltd. The Members of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated can take pride in our Club's contribution to this excellent result. Our challenge is to stabilise and strengthen existing income sources and to work towards establishing new and additional revenue streams to ensure that such results are achieved consistently into the future.

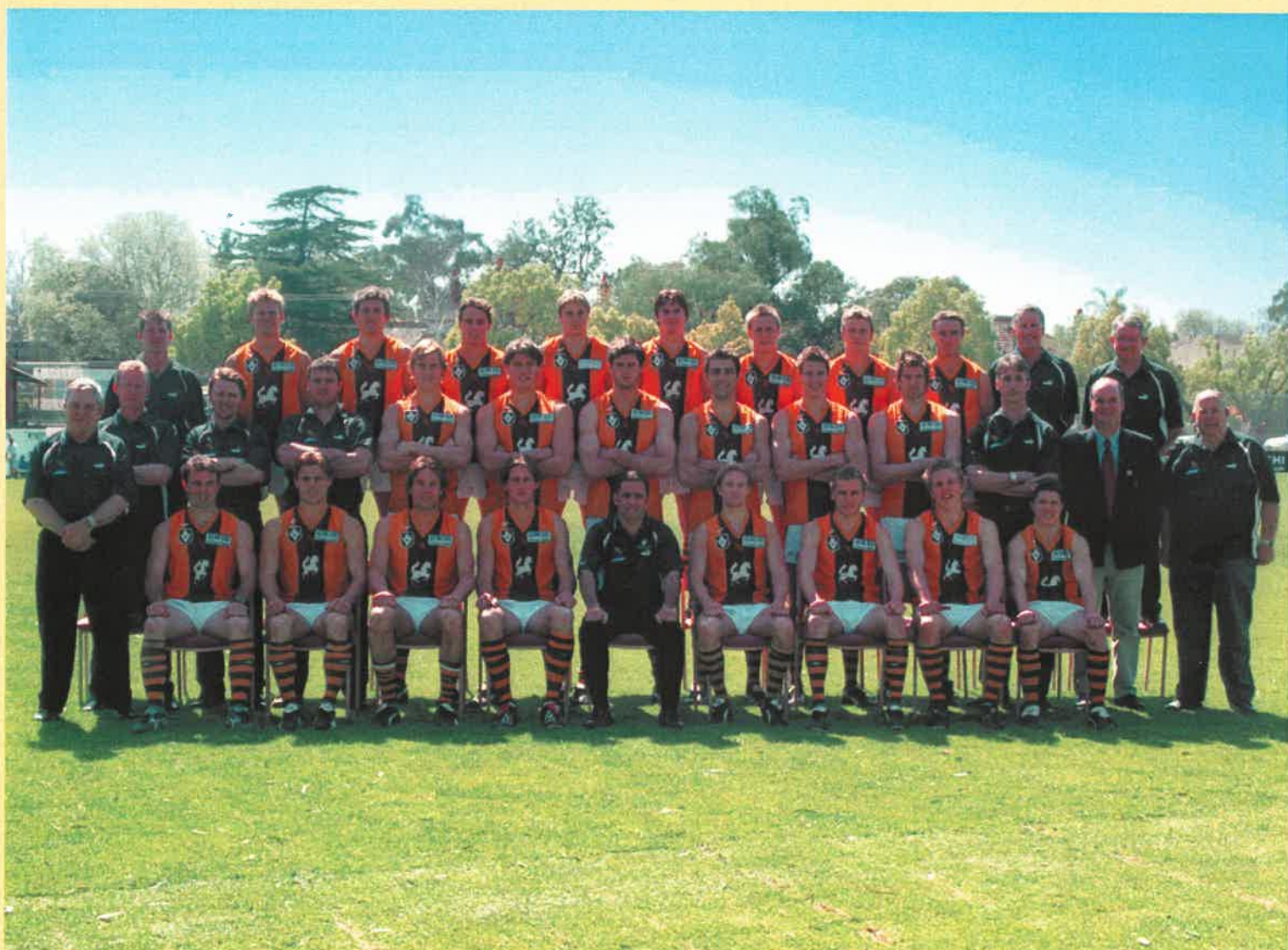
