President's Report

As I reflect upon the season past, it is with mixed emotion. 2004 was a year in which the Box Hill Hawks overcame a disastrous start to the season to confirm beyond all doubt our position as one of the leading Cubs in the modern Victorian Football League. It was also a year in which two of our Club's most significant contributors and greatest friends passed away within three weeks of each other.

Subsequent to our defeat in last year's Grand Final, Tony Liberatore was reappointed as Senior Coach for 2004. His performance during 2003 unquestionably warranted his reappointment, however, he made it clear at the time that he was actively pursuing a position within an A.F.L. coaching panel and that he would ask to be released of his contract if successful. With the wisdom of hindsight, I believe it was a mistake to appoint our Senior Coach under circumstances where his commitment to the Club was less than one hundred percent. When Tony told the Club in mid-December that he had accepted a position with the Carlton Football Club as an assistant coach, we were left only days before the Christmas break in pre-season training with a demoralised and confused group of players and without a Senior Coach.

Given the timing it was considered that the usual process of advertising and interview was not practicable. Instead, a short-list of likely candidates was drawn up and contacted directly to ascertain the level of interest. Within a week of Tony Liberatore departing the Club, Andrew Collins had been appointed as Senior Coach for 2004. Andy was considered a safe choice, with outstanding credentials as a triple Premiership player with Hawthorn and a V.F.L. Premiership Coach at Sandringham. His most recent Coaching appointment with Mitcham in the E.F.L. meant that he came to the Box Hill Hawks with an established support team and excellent knowledge of Football and footballers throughout the eastern suburbs.

Andy took control of pre-season training in mid-January. By this time many of our 2003 players had already departed the Club. When our 2004 list was finalised, only eight players remained from the previous season. We were heartened by the return of Clinton Alleway after one year on the Kangaroos Rookie List. Simon Taylor crossed Bass Strait to further his studies and joined the Box Hill Hawks with good V.F.L. credentials. Steven Bailey and Kristan Height arrived as proven E.F.L. players with limited V.F.L. experience. It was believed that we had assembled considerable talent, but we were concerned about our preparedness for the Football season due to the disrupted pre-season, unusually large turnover of players and the cancellation of all but two of our scheduled practice matches due to ground inavailability and extreme weather conditions. Our concerns proved to be well founded.

The opening six matches of the season were lost. Admittedly, due to the seeded draw, we had played most of the other Clubs that we anticipated would be in Finals contention. Our form was not disastrous; we were competitive but appeared to be lacking in confidence and cohesion. As late as the end of May, the Box Hill Hawks were still last on the ladder, with only one win from the opening nine Rounds. The fact that our A.F.L. partner was also struggling on-the-field and had experienced a number of off-field crises compounded our problems and added to the general air of gloom at the time. When it seemed that the Club's morale could sink no lower, we were rocked by the deaths of Ivan Moore and Brien McMahon during the month of June.

Ivan Moore's sudden passing was a great shock to all associated with the Box Hill Hawks. My first dealings with Ivan were during the negotiations in 1999 that led to the establishment of the alignment between the Hawthorn and Box Hill Football Clubs. It was obvious that he had a passion for community Football and a deep understanding of how a junior Football Club operated. He was a foundation member of the first Box Hill Hawks Board that met later that year and made an outstanding contribution to the great success that the Club has enjoyed since. Ivan's genial and inclusive style made him the obvious conduit between the Hawthorn and Box Hill interests on our Board; a link that I used on dozens of occasions to great advantage.

Three weeks later, Brien McMahon passed away. To those of us who had witnessed Brien's decline during a long and brave battle against a terminal disease it was no great shock, however, the fact that Brien's wife Bernice had also passed away a few weeks earlier added a sense of tragedy for the McMahon family to the sadness. Brien's contribution to the Club for over a decade in a variety of roles was significant and irreplaceable. Due to the many hours he spent at City Oval in his role as groundsman, he was for years the face of the Box Hill Football Club to the Whitehorse City Council, Eastern Ranges Football Club and the Box Hill Cricket Club. The value of the goodwill that he fostered with these organisations was incalculable. I think the significance of his contribution to the Club is best illustrated by the fact that only one person has won the trophy awarded annually by the Club's Directors for outstanding service on more than one occasion - Brien McMahon in 1998, 1999 and 2000. His contribution and, more importantly, friendship, shall be deeply missed.

At the same time as the Club was coming to terms with off-field sadness, our Football fortunes were gradually taking a turn for the better. Our V.F.L. listed players and a handful of Hawthorn youngsters started to gel as a unit and results at last began to reflect the undoubted talent that we believed all along was present within the team. Three matches were won in a row to leave the Box Hill Hawks just one game outside the Eight.



A thrashing at City Oval at the hands of the Coburg Tigers gave us a reality check, thereafter the Senior team won its final six home and away games. Included in a number of superb performances were an away ground victory against eventual Premier Sandringham and a back-from-the-dead triumph over the Northern Bullants in front of a boisterous home crowd. Possibly the most outstanding victory was witnessed by the fewest supporters: another come-from-behind win, this time against Geelong on one of the worst days for Football imaginable, a victory that guaranteed the Box Hill Hawks a fifth consecutive Finals appearance.

By this time our players had developed a tremendous self-belief and it was no surprise when this form was carried into the Finals. Two tense Finals matches were won narrowly to lift the Box Hill Hawks into a Preliminary Final and only one victory away from what would have been a third Grand Final appearance in four years. Port Melbourne, rested and playing on their home ground that was waterlogged from heavy overnight rain, ended our season, but our players fought with great credit under the difficult conditions.

The season of our Reserves team followed a similar pattern. After a slow start the team stormed home to record six victories and a draw in its final eight matches to narrowly miss a Finals berth. There is much talent on the Box Hill Hawks list; provided that the turnover in players can be reduced, I believe that our Club is well placed for another successful season in 2005.

Congratulations to our Senior Coach, Andy Collins, Reserves Coach, Martin Heppel, and the entire Match Committee for your achievements in 2004. The young Box Hill Hawks and Hawthorn listed players responded well to Andy's educational and uncompromising style; I am delighted that he has accepted our Board's invitation to remain as Senior Coach in 2005. I congratulate our talented band of players for your achievements this year, in particular our trophy winners and those that reached 50 game milestones.

There were several highlights for the Box Hill Hawks this year but there are two that I would particularly like to mention. Our Club cemented its reputation within the V.F.L. as the best breeding ground of A.F.L. talent. Four of the ten V.F.L. listed players in our 2003 Grand Final team were drafted, already Simon Taylor has been selected in the 2004 National Draft. In 2004, Matthew Bishop became the first player drafted from Box Hill to play in an A.F.L. Premiership. Indeed, since the first A.F.L. National Draft, twenty-three Box Hill players have been drafted - more than twice as many as from any other V.F.L. Club. While our policy of promoting young talent throughout the 1990s may have been driven by financial necessity, it is now an integral part of our Club's Football philosophy that has served us outstandingly in recent years.

The other highlight was the fact that the V.F.L. favoured our Club with a home ground Final for the third consecutive year. This is a tribute both to the Whitehorse City Council, which has transformed City Oval into one of the premier facilities in the V.F.L. competition, and to our magnificent supporters who turn up in large numbers to make City Oval the best attended Victorian venue in the V.F.L. On average in excess of 600 Hawthorn Members attend our home games, one of the real strengths of the Box Hill Hawks - Hawthorn alignment. On a glorious late-August afternoon, City Oval looked an absolute picture and our players responded to the urging of a 2000-strong pro-Hawks crowd to claim victory over the Coburg Tigers.

Our Club has exciting plans to further develop City Oval to its ultimate potential, about which we are presently in discussions with the Whitehorse City Council, Football Victoria and the Hawthorn Football Club. If successful, it will secure our Club's and Football's long term position in the heartland of Melbourne's eastern suburbs.

I thank my fellow Directors of the Box Hill Hawks for your sound management of the Club during the season. My role as President is made easy by the support of a united Board representing both the Box Hill and Hawthorn sides of the alignment all working towards a common goal.

I acknowledge the tremendous support that our Club has again received from the Hawthorn Football Club. The strength and quality of our relationship was emphasised during a year of turmoil for our A.F.L. partner. I thank the President of the Hawthorn Football Club, Mr. Ian Dicker, and the General Manager of Football Operations, Mr. John Hook, for the active interest that they take in our Club.

Special mention to the General Manager of the Box Hill Hawks, Andrew Pirchan, and his assistant, Bob Lyford. Both Andrew and Bob have worked very hard and very professionally to ensure that the Box Hill Hawks is financially sound, as well as being a successful Club.

To all our sponsors, we thank you for your contribution and support. We hope that your business has benefited from your involvement with the Box Hill Hawks and, just as importantly, that you have enjoyed being associated with our Club.

To our loyal and dedicated team of support staff and volunteers, a sincere thank you. You are the heart and soul of our Club and we would not be able to function without you.

Finally, I thank the Members of the Box Hill Football Club and the Directors of the Box Hill Hawks for granting me the privilege of serving as you as President of this great Club. To all, I extend my best wishes for a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

Finance Report

The operations of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated once again made an important contribution to the financial operations of the Box Hill Hawks, with profit appropriated to this entity increasing from \$35,675 in 2003 to \$52,216 during the year past. The Club again incurred minimal trading expenses during the year; the final trading result was a retained operating deficit of \$2,806 due mainly to depreciation charges against the Club's fixed assets.

Bingo, Social Club and the sale of Memberships are the main operations which remain under the auspices of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated and its associated groups. Detailed below is a brief overview of these results.

Bingo

Net after-GST revenue from Bingo increased from \$30,589 in 2003 to \$47,184 in 2004. A dark shadow hangs over this seemingly pleasing result: ownership of the Box Hill Central Bingo Centre changed on 31st October, 2004 and at the time of writing this report the Centre is closed for renovation and no commitment has been given by the new owners to existing Permit holders at the Centre that they will retain their sessions. It is quite possible that the Club will not be conducting Bingo into 2005 after more than 20 years riding the highs and lows that Bingo has provided.

To the outgoing Management of the Box Hill Central Bingo Centre, Denis Corless and Deborah Kearns, a sincere and heart-felt thank you for the magnificent support that you have given to our Club over many years.

Membership

Membership of the Box Hill Football Club totalled 191 persons in 2004, comprising 71 Life Members, 90 Financial Members of the Box Hill Football Club and 30 Members of the Box Hill Football Club Past Players and Officials Association. Membership revenue in 2004 was \$5,068, almost identical to the previous year.

Social Club

Our thanks is extended to the Committee of the Box Hill Football Club Social Club, led by David White, who were again responsible for the operation of the Social Rooms and the conduct of Bingo sessions at the Box Hill Central Bingo Centre.

The average V.F.L. attendance at City Oval reduced from 1,752 in 2003 to 1,555 in 2004; a trend experienced by virtually all V.F.L. Clubs. However, good results from the well-attended V.F.L. Final and a number of V.A.F.A. Finals ensured that Social Club revenue was comparable with the previous year.

The Future

It is pleasing to report that the Box Hill Hawks Ltd recorded a second consecutive trading profit in 2004. The Members of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated can take pride in our Club's contribution to this excellent result. However, with our main financial contribution to the Box Hill Hawks, Bingo, facing a most uncertain future, we face a significant challenge to continue to strongly support the Box Hill Hawks. The challenge for our Club now is to work towards establishing new revenue streams to ensure that such results are achieved consistently into the future.

PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The principal activities of the association were the management and promotion of an Australian Rules Football Club affiliated with the Victorian Football League. The year was the second year of the association's second three-year agreement with the Hawthorn Football Club Ltd to operate the Box Hill Hawks Ltd; a joint venture company established to field teams in Victorian Football League and to pursue the aims and objectives of both organisations. Under the terms of the agreement, the association appoints three of the six members and four of the ten directors of the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These appointments are made in accordance with the Rules of the association. The present agreement concludes on 31st October, 2005.

RESULTS

The operating profit for the period was \$49,410. An appropriation of \$52,216 was made to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, resulting in a retained operating deficit of \$2,806 (2003 result: \$32,143 operating profit; \$35,675 appropriation to Box Hill Hawks Ltd; \$3,532 retained operating deficit).

DIVIDENDS

The Club is an incorporated association and is not permitted under its Rules to make any distributions to its members.

REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

As part of the agreement entered into by the association to form the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, and as a fifty percent partner in the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, the association continued to operate its Social Club and Bingo operations during the year in furtherance of its aims and objectives and appropriated profit from these operations to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These factors resulted in a small retained operating deficit and a slight reduction in the surplus of assets over liabilities at balance date.

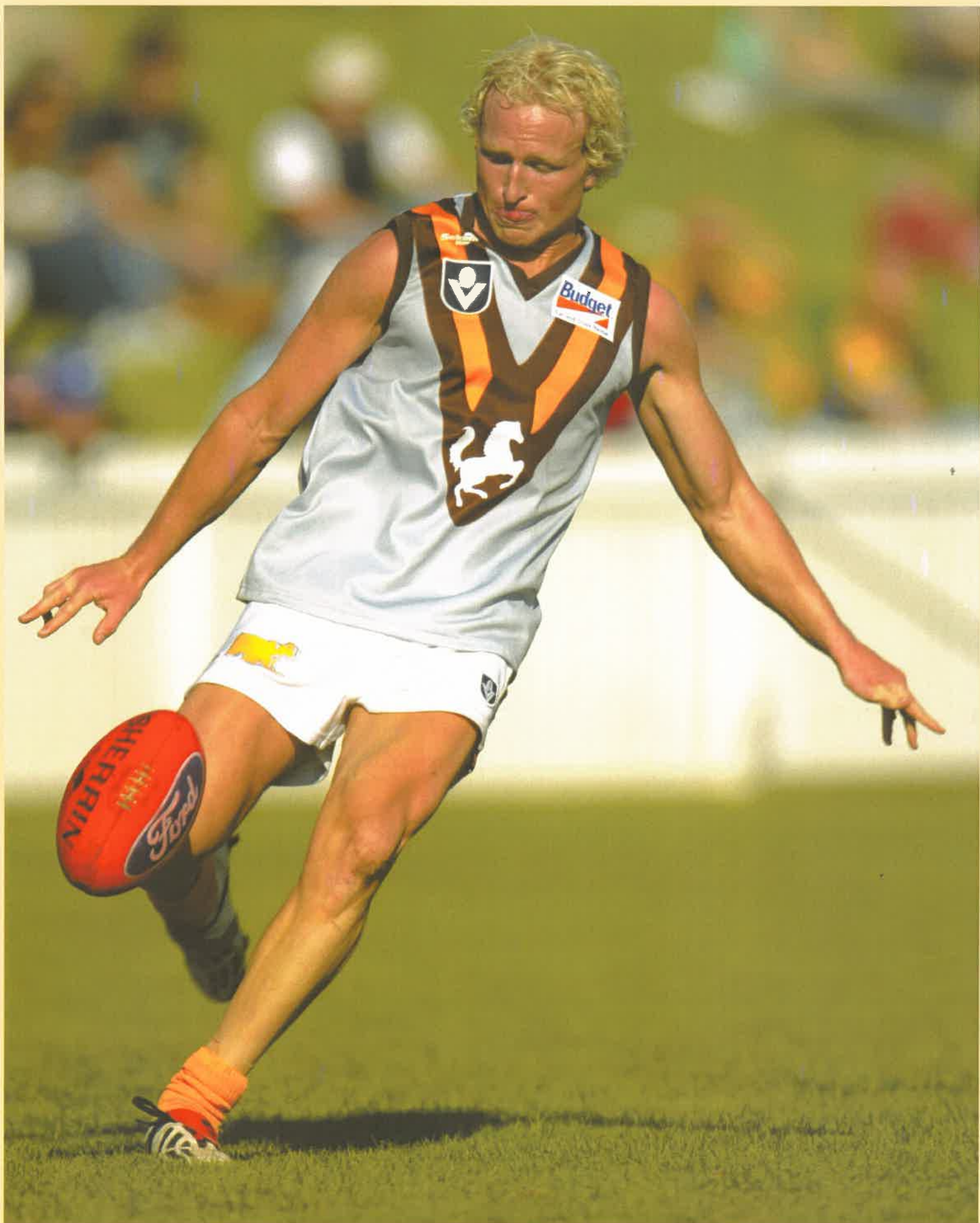
