President's Report

The year past was one of mixed fortunes and change for the Box Hill Hawks. Both our Seniors and Reserves teams participated in the Finals, yet it is fair to say that our on-field performances fell short of the high standard that our Club has established in recent years. Off the field there were several events of importance and significance that may well cause us in five or ten years time to look back on 2005 as a watershed year.

After our fourth placed finish in 2004, the Box Hill Hawks enjoyed a stable off season. Senior Coach Andy Collins and his support staff were reappointed for 2005. The process was not as straightforward as may have been expected under normal circumstances. A new broom had swept clean through the Football Department of our A.F.L. partner, Hawthorn. It is fair to say that after the appointment of their new Senior Coach, Alistair Clarkson, all positions within the Hawthorn and Box Hill Hawks Football structure came under review. It was only after very strong representations from the Box Hill Hawks Board that Andy Collins was confirmed as our Senior Coach for 2005.

Off season recruiting focused primarily on young talent, consistent with our successful philosophy of recent years. It was believed that the final playing list had a better depth of talent than in previous years, however, lacked experience due to the departure of several established V.F.L. players. The loss of Steven Bailey and Ben Neagle to South Australian Clubs was a disappointment and the continuing talent drain from the V.F.L. to the W.A.F.L. and S.A.N.F.L. is a serious issue for the V.F.L. competition to address. Andrew Pugsley and Tyson Collins returned to local Football; with the wisdom of hindsight the Club should have fought harder to retain experienced players such as this. Simon Taylor and Kirstan Height were drafted and rookie listed by Hawthorn respectively, while Michael Rix, after spending the 2004 season as a Hawthorn Rookie, joined the Coburg Tigers to pursue his A.F.L. dream.

A strong win at Williamstown in the opening game promised much but three losses followed and the season never reached great heights. Possibly the best form was shown from Rounds 5 to 8 when three out of four games were won including victories over top four teams the Northern Bullants and Sandringham. Thereafter several games were lost when a winning position late in the last quarter was squandered and the occasional victory maintained a position at the lower end of the Eight. Having seemingly thrown away our chances of playing in the Finals, the Box Hill Hawks sat out the final week of the home and away season in eighth place and watched all of our challengers for a Finals berth stumble. With only seven victories we could hardly claim to be deserving Finalists, but Finalists we were for the sixth consecutive season.

By the end of the home and away season we were relying more on our Box Hill Hawks listed players than ever before as Hawthorn's injury list grew from long to ridiculous. For our Elimination Final against Port Melbourne only four Hawthorn listed players were available. Our opponents, with a full quota of twelve Kangaroos players selected, soundly defeated us to end our season.

Of much merit was the performance of our Reserves who claimed a Finals berth for the first time since the 2002 season. Relying almost exclusively on Box Hill Hawks listed players of under 22 years of age, the team won three of its first four games and thereafter displayed consistent form to maintain a place in the Five for the remainder of the season. Unfortunately the long injury lists at both Hawthorn and the Box Hill Hawks meant that by the end of the home and away season only fifteen players were available for selection. Seven players had to be recruited from Eastern Football League Clubs for their only V.F.L. game for the season to enable the Club to field a full team in the Elimination Final. Predictably the Reserves also exited the Premiership race in the first week of the Finals, but the team gave a good account of itself in a tenacious performance against Werribee.

Despite our mixed on-field results, there were several outstanding individual performances from our players. I particularly congratulate those that won trophies and achieved the milestone of 50 Senior games in 2005. Once again there is much talent on the Box Hill Hawks list and again it would not surprise to see one or two of our players elevated an A.F.L. list next year.

To our coaching staff, lead by Andy Collins and Reserves Coach Martin Heppel, I thank you for sincerely your efforts in a challenging and at times difficult year. As well as coping with an unusually long injury list, the many changes at Hawthorn created problems during the year. This is not said as a criticism directed at any individual but as a statement of fact. Prior to 2005, Peter Schwab was the only Senior Coach at Hawthorn since the Clubs first aligned. It was inevitable that a new Senior Coach would introduce different ideas, structures and methods and that there would be associated change to the arrangements between Hawthorn and the Box Hill Hawks. With the wisdom of hindsight, it is fair to say that these should have been better anticipated by our Club.

Andy Collins will not be coaching the Box Hill Hawks in 2006 and has accepted the Senior Coach's position at the Coburg Tigers. The Box Hill Hawks Board had determined that the Senior Coach's role would revert to a full time position for next year, integrated into the Hawthorn Coaching structure. Andy's employment with Cricket Victoria prevented him from accepting this role. Martin Heppel too has moved on and will coach Mitcham in the Eastern Football League next year. Both Andy and Martin gave the Box Hill Hawks great service during the past two years and we wish them success for the future.



Without doubt the great highlights of the 2005 season occurred off the field. After hosting a highly successful and well attended game at City Oval on Anzac Day, the Football Gods smiled on the Box Hill Hawks and decreed that the Round 11 game against Williamstown should be the comeback game from long term injury for Hawthorn star Angelo Lekkas and Collingwood Captain Nathan Buckley. Despite threatening weather, a magnificent crowd of 5,253 filled City Oval to witness the spectacle, the largest crowd at the venue in over two decades. In the full glare of the A.F.L. media machine, our Club conducted itself with great credit and professionalism and showed that we had learnt much from earlier "blockbuster" games at City Oval during the 2001 and 2002 seasons.

The most welcome additional revenue from this game ensured that the Box Hill Hawks declared a profit result for the third consecutive season. In a year in which the Club relied entirely on direct Football revenue, after new owners at the Box Hill Central Bingo Centre unceremoniously evicted all existing permit holders late last year, this was a magnificent achievement. The continuing hard work and professionalism of the General Manager of the Box Hill Hawks, Andrew Pirchan, and his assistant, Bob Lyford, cannot be praised too highly.

The most significant off field event occurred on 15th August, 2005 when Whitehorse Council resolved to vary the traditional six month on / six month off arrangement between Football and Cricket at Box Hill City Oval. The effect of the Council Resolution is to give the Box Hill Hawks access to City Oval during the month of March for training and practice matches.

It is not appropriate to go through all the issues in this Report but I state categorically that our Club did not pursue this outcome with the objective of disadvantaging the Box Hill Cricket Club. In fact, we negotiated for many months with the Cricket Club to achieve an agreed position. In the past two decades the Box Hill Football Club has progressed from the V.F.A. Second Division to the V.F.L., hosting elite A.F.L. listed Footballers. Our Club's needs based on our ever increasing professionalism have increased dramatically, yet the basis on which we occupy City Oval, as a six-monthly tenant annually renewing, has fundamentally remained unchanged in that time.

It was in response to this issue, with the backing of our key stakeholders Football Victoria and the Hawthorn Football Club, the Box Hill Hawks put forward a proposal to Whitehorse Council that Football stakeholders would make available \$450,000 for further improvements at City Oval (in addition to almost \$350,000 already provided in 2002) in return for improved access to Box Hill City Oval. Fortunately we were able to convince Council of the merit of our proposal. We are most grateful of Council's support on this issue and look forward with keen anticipation to the further development of City Oval in the near future which will benefit all stakeholders in this wonderful community facility.

We anticipate that the Council Resolution will be finalised by means of a five year lease on these terms before the start of the 2006 Football season. Flowing from this is a new agreement between the Box Hill Hawks and the Hawthorn Football Club that has already been agreed in principle and will extend our partnership until at least the end of the 2010 Football season. These two agreements when formalised will secure the Box Hill Hawks' future at City Oval for the long term and represent an outstanding outcome for our Club.

I acknowledge the tremendous support of my fellow Directors of the Box Hill Hawks, not just through this process, but in all areas of the Club's administration. I particularly make mention of John Hook, who resigned earlier this year; John was a wonderful and strong contributor to the excellent relationship between our Club and the Hawthorn Football Club. I also acknowledge the contributions of Ken Carnie and Ian Dicker who will be retiring as Directors of the Hawthorn Football Club at their Annual General Meeting to be conducted in forthcoming days.

The contribution of Ian Dicker to the success of the Box Hill Hawks over the past six years cannot be understated. It is fair to state that without the vision and passion of Ian and the late Ivan Moore from the Hawthorn side of our "marriage" it may well not have occurred in the first place let alone become the outstanding success into which it has developed. I am delighted that Ian has indicated that he wishes to retain an active interest in the Box Hill Hawks. I am also greatly heartened by initial meetings and discussions with Hawthorn's President-elect, Hon. Jeff Kennett, that the strong support and active interest that our Club has enjoyed from our A.F.L. partner will continue and grow further into the future.

To all our sponsors, we thank you for your contribution and support. We hope that your business has benefited from your involvement with the Box Hill Hawks and, just as importantly, that you have enjoyed being associated with our Club.

To our loyal and dedicated team of support staff and volunteers, a sincere thank you. You are the heart and soul of our Club and we would not be able to function without you.

Damien Christensen has been appointed as Senior Coach of the Box Hill Hawks for 2006. With an outstanding record as a career coach at both the Under 18 and Senior levels, Damien has the necessary credentials to lead the Club to an unprecedented seventh consecutive Finals appearance next year.

Finally, I thank the Members of the Box Hill Football Club and the Directors of the Box Hill Hawks for granting me the privilege of serving as you as President of this great Club. To all, I extend my best wishes for a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

Finance Report

The operations of the Box Hill Football Club contributed only \$5,391 to the Box Hill Hawks during 2005 as for the first time in a quarter of a century the Club did not conduct Bingo. As a result the Club had minimal operating revenue or expenses during the year with the final result being a retained operating deficit of \$3,206 after depreciation charges were taken into account against the Club's fixed assets. Without Bingo, Social Club and Membership sales were the only operations which remained under the auspices of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated.

Bingo

Ownership of the Box Hill Central Bingo Centre changed on 1st November, 2004 and after the Centre reopened in December none of the previous permit holders were offered sessions. What was most disappointing was the manner in which this was done with, not even the courtesy of a meeting or an explanation offered to the community groups that had supported the Centre for many years.

Membership

Membership of the Box Hill Football Club totalled 191 persons in 2005, comprising 69 Life Members, 111 Financial Members of the Box Hill Football Club and 2 Members of the Box Hill Football Club Past Players and Officials Association. Membership revenue in 2005 was \$5,391, a slight increase from the previous year.

Social Club

Our thanks is extended to the Committee of the Box Hill Football Club Social Club, led by David White, who were again responsible for the operation of the Social Rooms.

The average V.F.L. attendance at City Oval increased from 1,555 in 2004 to 1,901 in 2005; driven by a successful game conducted on Anzac Day and the blockbuster crowd that attended the Box Hill Hawks vs Williamstown game on 19th June, 2005.

The Future

With minimal operations remaining under the control of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated and with the alignment between Box Hill and Hawthorn now well matured, it is the Board's view that there is no practical reason of maintaining the separate entities of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated and the Box Hill Hawks Limited and that these two entities should be merged to streamline all operations. Accordingly, it is the Board's intention to put this proposal to the Members of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated in the near future.

Even though the Box Hill Hawks returned a third successive profit, it is a matter of great concern that the Club is now operating without external non-Football based income. The challenge to establish new revenue streams is a pressing one and the support of all Members is sought in this regard.

Your Board of Management submits the following report for the year ended 31st October, 2005.

SIGNATORIES

PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The principal activities of the association were the management and promotion of an Australian Rules Football Club affiliated with the Victorian Football League. The year was the final year of the association's second three-year agreement with the Hawthorn Football Club Ltd to operate the Box Hill Hawks Ltd; a joint venture company established to field teams in Victorian Football League and to pursue the aims and objectives of both organisations. Under the terms of the agreement, the association appoints three of the six members and four of the ten directors of the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These appointments are made in accordance with the Rules of the association.

RESULTS

The operating profit for the period was \$2,185. An appropriation of \$5,391 was made to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, resulting in a retained operating deficit of \$3,206 (2004 result: \$49,410 operating profit; \$52,216 appropriation to Box Hill Hawks Ltd; \$2,806 retained operating deficit).

DIVIDENDS

The Club is an incorporated association and is not permitted under its Rules to make any distributions to its members.

REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

As part of the agreement entered into by the association to form the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, and as a fifty percent partner in the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, the association continued to operate its Social Club operations during the year in furtherance of its aims and objectives and appropriated profit from these operations to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These factors resulted in a small retained operating deficit and a slight reduction in the surplus of assets over liabilities at balance date.

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

There was no significant change in the operations of the association during the period.

EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO BALANCE DATE

There has not arisen during the interval between the end of this financial period and the date of this report any item, transaction or event of a material or unusual nature likely in the opinion of the Board of Management of the association to affect substantially the results of the association for the next succeeding financial period.

LIKELY DEVELOPMENTS

No information is included on the likely developments in the operations of the association and the expected results of the association as it is in the opinion of the Board of Management of the association that this information would prejudice the interests of the association if it were included in this report.

BOARD OF MANagements' BENEFITS

Since the end of the previous financial period, no member of the Board of Management of association has received or become entitled to receive a benefit (other than a benefit included in the aggregate amount of emoluments received or due and receivable by the directors shown in the accounts) by reason of a contract made by the association or by a related corporation with the member of the Board of Management or with a firm of which he is a member, or with a company in which he has a substantial financial interest.
