President's Report

The year past contained more than the usual range of challenges for the Box Hill Hawks Football Club. In some areas significant advances were made, in other areas we took a step backwards or held our ground. Overall, I believe as a Club we emerged on the credit side of the ledger.

Those who observe from outside primarily judge a Football Club's performance by the ladder position of the Senior team but that does not always tell the full picture. Our Seniors missed the Finals for the first time since 1999 and our tenth place on the ladder was our lowest finish for a decade. It was always going to be a challenging year with the loss of so much experience from the Box Hill Hawks list. The departure of Captain Clinton Alleway to the S.A.N.F.L., Brendan Rinaldi to the W.A.F.L., Alistair Neville who followed Andy Collins to the Coburg Tigers, A.F.L. drafted players Cam Howat and Ben McGlynn and experienced V.F.L. campaigners such as Daniel Breese and Tim Harvey back to local Football left a huge hole. On the positive side we were joined by Cameron Hunter and David King and re-joined by Kristan Height who had all spent time on A.F.L. lists. Coupled with our inexperience was the fact that Hawthorn's A.F.L. list was at a similar stage of the development cycle, having commenced a rebuilding phase at the end of the 2004 Season.

All things taken into account, the fact that we won only one less game than 2005 could be considered a reasonable performance. More often than not the team was extremely competitive and we recorded some excellent victories, however, our two performances against the Northern Bullants showed in the space of just two seasons how far we had fallen behind V.F.L. Football played at the highest standard.

The on-going drain of V.F.L. talent to the S.A.N.F.L. and W.A.F.L., fuelled by huge differences in financial capacity and perceived differences in player opportunity, presents an enormous challenge to our competition. Certainly our Club is not alone in this regard within the V.F.L.; however, it gives me no pleasure to record that former Box Hill Hawks players such as Clinton Alleway, Steven Bailey, Steve Kenna, Ben Neagle, Mark Passador, Brendan Rinaldi and Matt Smith were in 2006 playing Football at a very high standard in either South Australia or Western Australia. I would venture the opinion that having even half of these players on the Box Hill Hawks' 2006 list would have resulted in a seventh consecutive Finals appearance.

As a Club we need to respond to this challenge by building a strong Football environment that encourages talented young players to remain with the Box Hill Hawks even after dream of an A.F.L. career may have passed them by. We must value player milestones of 50 and 100 Senior games. We must value the performances of our Reserves team and to make young players understand that the very high standard of the V.F.L. means that regular Reserves Football early in their career is inevitable. I believe that we have made some progress in this regard and much has improved since some of the short-sighted player management decisions made during the period 2003 and 2004.

I thank our Coaching panel for their efforts during 2006, in particular, our first-year Senior Coach Damien Christensen. Damien's talents in developing young players became obvious as the season unfolded, the fruits of which we started to see during the month of September. He has earned the opportunity in 2007 to build on this work.

Those of us who came away from Launceston in late-August believing that the Box Hill Hawks 2006 season had ended with barely a whimper received a most welcome boost over the next four weeks. Our Reserves won the Premiership from fourth place on the ladder, with four superb Finals victories. In an astounding Grand Final performance, our players adapted magnificently to the wet and windy conditions to inflict the only defeat for the season on the Williamstown team, who had trounced us by 124 points in the first game of the season. Just as meritorious was the Semi-Final victory over a Northern Bullants team that included eight Carlton-listed players, forced back to the Reserves by the "12/10" rule.

No Club has ever achieved greatness by winning Reserve Grade Premierships. However, considering that our Finals teams comprised entirely V.F.L. listed players; the young age of the team (average just 20.4 years) and that eighteen of the Grand Final twenty-two have already tasted Senior Football, we have a strong platform from which to rebuild our playing list. We can be confident that our next visit to the upper echelons of the Senior V.F.L. competition is not too far away.

To our Reserves Coach, Kevin Tibaldi, and all players who represented the Reserves, I extend my sincere congratulations on your achievements in 2006. At last, in our sixth Grand Final appearance in the Reserve Grade since joining the V.F.A. in 1951, we have a Premiership in this competition to accompany our three Senior Grade and two Under 19s Grade Premierships.

There were several outstanding individual performances from our players during 2006 and I congratulate all trophy winners. The effort of Matthew Ball to become only the seventh player to win Box Hill's Club Champion Award on more than one occasion is worthy of particular mention. It is a reflection of the modern Football world that he becomes the first player to win our Club's highest individual player honour as both a V.F.L. and A.F.L. listed player. I am delighted that, despite being de-listed by Hawthorn at the end of the 2006 season, Matthew has signed with the Box Hill Hawks for 2007 as he strives to become the first player in eight years to reach the 100 game milestone for our Club.

It is also worth mentioning that in 2006 three more players drafted from the Box Hill Hawks made their A.F.L. debuts; Cam Howat, Ben McGlynn and Michael Rix. Surely no other state league Club in Australia can rival our Club's proven ability to develop A.F.L. talent.



Off-the-field, your Board of Management grappled with several issues that are most important to the long term future of the Club. Certainly the most vexing has been the issue of funding and progressing further necessary ground improvements at Box Hill City Oval. In February 2006, after a concerted political campaign by the Box Hill Cricket Club, Whitehorse Council reversed its earlier Resolution to grant the Box Hill Hawks unrestricted access to City Oval during the month of March. There is no merit in canvassing the many and complex issues here, however, if this outcome is viewed as a victory for the Box Hill Cricket Club, it must be considered as a Pyrrhic one, achieved at the cost of jeopardising a \$450,000 contribution pledged by Football stakeholders towards capital works at Box Hill City Oval that would have greatly benefited both Clubs.

This Club will continue to work constructively with Whitehorse Council and all other stakeholders at Box Hill City Oval to find a way to fund and complete the City Oval Master Plan that was developed in 2001. We are also negotiating with Council a long-term lease for City Oval as your Board of Management views this as imperative if we are to further invest in our playing venue. May I record here that we have greatly appreciated the ready availability at all times of both Councilors and Officers to discuss these important issues. With the goodwill of all involved I am sure that a way forward can be found.

Despite frustrations we have made progress in these areas. Our Club is most appreciative of the great support that Council has already provided through the funding of capital works about to take place at City Oval. The upgrade of the main Whitehorse Road entrance and car park and removal of the Cricket practice wickets from the playing arena are scheduled to be completed prior to the 2007 Football season. These are important works that will provide lasting benefits. We are also delighted that Council has consented to our Club's request to name the new entrance the "Ron and Barbara Gibbs Entrance" in honour of two of the great stalwarts of the Box Hill Football Club.

During the year the Club has also finalised terms of a new five-year agreement with the Hawthorn Football Club that will see the alignment continue until the end of the 2011 Football season. This is a magnificent outcome for this Club, not only is it more financially favourable, but the long-term gives us great confidence to plan for the future. As part of this new agreement, your Board of Management is recommending a merger of the Box Hill Football Club Inc and Box Hill Hawks Ltd entities to streamline Club operations. This is fully detailed in the Special Resolution contained in this Report and, we believe, is a sensible evolution of the management of this Club that reflects after seven years the maturity of the relationship between the Hawthorn and Box Hill Football Clubs.

Through all these endeavours my fellow Directors of the Box Hill Hawks have provided tremendous support for which I am most grateful. In particular I would like to thank Jim Conway who stood in for me on occasions during 2006 when I was unavailable and filled the role with aplomb.

We also are most fortunate, in Andrew Pirchan and Bob Lyford, to have the service of two of the most competent administrators in the history of this Club. Through their efforts the Box Hill Hawks recorded a fourth consecutive operating profit, an absolutely outstanding achievement. The turn-around that has been achieved in the Club's finances in recent years is nothing short of remarkable and we are now in the happy position of having no external debt and being able to set aside cash from day-to-day operations to be used for projects in the future. It is over two decades since the Box Hill Football Club has been in such a comfortable financial position. That being said, we do need to remember that history teaches us how hard earned and easily squandered such an achievement can be.

I gratefully acknowledge the on-going support the Box Hill Hawks receives from the Hawthorn Football Club and the active interest taken in our Club by their President, Hon. Jeff Kennett, Chief Executive Officer, Ian Robson, and General Manager of Football Operations, Mark Evans.

It is a comfort to me to know that these people are at all times willing to make their time available for the Box Hill Hawks to assist us wherever possible.

I acknowledge also the support our Club has received from Football Victoria, particularly through our negotiations with Whitehorse Council regarding capital works at City Oval. In particular the chairman, Bob Tregear, and Chief Executive Officer, Ken Gannon, have provided much counsel and advice through this process. After a fifteen year involvement with Victorian Football that has seen the remnants of the old V.F.A. competition transformed into the vibrant V.F.L. that it is today, Ken Gannon is moving onto a new role within the A.F.L. On behalf of all members of the Box Hill Football Club I thank Ken for all he has done for this Club and Victorian Football in general and wish him well for the future.

To all our sponsors, we thank you for your contribution and support. We hope that your business has benefited from your involvement with the Box Hill Hawks and, just as importantly, that you have enjoyed being associated with our Club.

To our loyal and dedicated team of support staff and volunteers, once again, a sincere thank you. You are the heart and soul of our Club and we would not be able to function without you. I am pleased to note that the Club is honouring two of our long serving volunteers, David Behan and Rod McDonald, with nominations for Life Membership which I commend warmly to Members for your endorsement.

Finally, I thank the Members of the Box Hill Football Club for granting me the privilege of serving as you as President of this great Club. While I indicated at last's years Annual General Meeting that I felt that 2006 would be my last as President, I feel that there is still some unfinished business that I would like to see through. On that basis, I am happy to offer myself to the Club's Members to fulfil this role once again in 2007.

Nominations for Life Membership

In accordance with the Rules of the Constitution of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated, the Board of Management has pleasure in recommending the following two persons for Life Membership to the Members of the Club:

- Mr. David Behan for outstanding service to the Club as a member of the General Committee for many years. David is undoubtedly one of the most active, reliable and enthusiastic helpers and supporters that the Club has been fortunate to have. For many years he has filled a variety of roles on home match days including serving in the beer booth and operating the scoreboard. On numerous occasions he has willingly assisted the Club's administration in a variety of ways.
- Mr. Rod McDonald who has completed ten years of service to the Club in an official capacity. Since 1997 Rod has served the Club in a number of different Football operations roles including as Seniors Team Manager, Reserves Team Manager and as a member of the Match Committee. During 1998 and 1999 he served as a member of the Club's Board of Management.

The Board of Management trusts that these recommendations meet with the approval of the Members of the Club.

Consideration of Special Resolution

In accordance with the Rules of the Constitution of the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated, Members have been given twenty-one (21) days notice of the following Resolution to be considered at this Annual General Meeting:

1. Introduction

Members are aware that, since December 1999, the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated ("BHFC Inc") and the Hawthorn Football Club Limited ("HFC Ltd") have operated a joint venture company, the Box Hill Hawks Limited ("BHH Ltd") to participate in the V.F.L. competition.

While the reasons for establishing this structure were important at the time, over the past seven years virtually all operations of BHFC Inc have been progressively transferred to BHH Ltd. As such, the entity BHFC Inc's only remaining functions now are to:

- (i) Sell Memberships in accordance with its Rules and VFL Regulations; and
- (ii) Annually appoint four directors to the BHH Ltd Board.

In addition, the operation of two entities, BHFC Inc and BHH Ltd, necessitates the operation of two companies, the submission of two Annual Returns and the conduct of two Annual General Meetings which adds significant complexity to the Club's administration.

The Board of Management of BHFC Inc believes that it is now appropriate that the two companies are amalgamated into a single entity.

2. The Proposal

In practical terms, the simplest way to achieve the above outcome is to wind-up BHFC Inc and to transfer any remaining assets to BHH Ltd in accordance with Clause 6 of the BHFC Inc's Statement of Purposes, while ensuring that all existing rights of BHFC Inc Members are retained.

As at 31st October, 2006, BHFC Inc has no debt and assets valued at \$18,991; comprising cash at bank (\$39), plant and equipment (\$4,745) and property improvements (\$14,207).

In putting this recommendation to the Members of the BHFC Inc, the Club's Board of Management has ensured that, as part of the future operations of the BHH Ltd, all rights presently vested in Members of the BHFC Inc are retained, including:

- (i) All Life Members of BHFC Inc to be recognised as Life Members of BHH Ltd and to receive an annual Membership ticket;
- (ii) Four of the nine directors of BHH Ltd to be appointed annually from amongst the Club's Membership ticket holders; and
- (iii) Continuity of recognition of all aspects of the Box Hill Football Club's history.

The three Clubs have concluded negotiation of a new five-year agreement covering the operation of the Box Hill Hawks Football Club to the end of the 2011 season on these terms.

3. Special Resolution

"That the Box Hill Football Club Incorporated (A 002 273 6A) is wound up and applies for deregistration and that, after settlement of all debts and liabilities, any remaining assets shall be transferred to the Box Hill Hawks Limited (ACN 090 410 227)."

In accordance with the Rules of the Constitution of the BHFC Inc, a vote with a three-quarters majority of Members in attendance at the Annual General Meeting in favour of the Resolution is required for it to be carried.

PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The principal activities of the association were the management and promotion of an Australian Rules Football Club affiliated with the Victorian Football League. The year was the fourth and final year of the association's second agreement with the Hawthorn Football Club Ltd to operate the Box Hill Hawks Ltd; a joint venture company established to field teams in Victorian Football League and to pursue the aims and objectives of both organisations. Under the terms of the agreement, the association appoints three of the six members and four of the nine directors of the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These appointments are made in accordance with the Rules of the association.

RESULTS

The operating profit for the period was \$1,126. An appropriation of \$4,655 was made to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, resulting in a retained operating deficit of \$3,529 (2005 result: \$2,185 operating profit; \$5,391 appropriation to Box Hill Hawks Ltd; \$3,206 retained operating deficit).

DIVIDENDS

The Club is an incorporated association and is not permitted under its Rules to make any distributions to its members.

REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

As part of the agreement entered into by the association to form the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, and as a fifty percent partner in the Box Hill Hawks Ltd, the association continued its operations during the year in furtherance of its aims and objectives and appropriated profit from these operations to the Box Hill Hawks Ltd. These factors resulted in a small retained operating deficit and a slight reduction in the surplus of assets over liabilities at balance date.

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

There was no significant change in the operations of the association during the period.

EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO BALANCE DATE

There has not arisen during the interval between the end of this financial period and the date of this report any item, transaction or event of a material or unusual nature likely in the opinion of the Board of Management of the association to affect substantially the results of the association for the next succeeding financial period.

LIKELY DEVELOPMENTS

No information is included on the likely developments in the operations of the association and the expected results of the association as it is in the opinion of the Board of Management of the association that this information would prejudice the interests of the association if it were included in this report.

BOARD OF MANAGERMENTS' BENEFITS

Since the end of the previous financial period, no member of the Board of Management of association has received or become entitled to receive a benefit (other than a benefit included in the aggregate amount of emoluments received or due and receivable by the directors shown in the accounts) by reason of a contract made by the association or by a related corporation with the member of the Board of Management or with a firm of which he is a member, or with a company in which he has a substantial financial interest.
