Football Operations Report

In 2021 the competition continued to face challenges as restrictions and lockdowns restricted the A.F.L.'s ability to complete a V.F.L. season for the second year running. Box Hill was well placed before the league was forced to cancel the season with Box Hill sitting 8-2 on the ladder having won the last six games in a row.

Although disappointing we still have plenty to be proud of in 2021, notably having two players drafted from Box Hill to Hawthorn. Congratulations to both Lachlan Bramble and Jai Newcombe. Lachie joined the Club and immediately made an impact at training before shining in Hawthorn intra-club's and scratch matches across the pre-season. It didn't take long for Hawthorn to pull the trigger. Jai went from strength to strength over the pre-season and forced his way into our best 22 before banging down the door with six outstanding games of V.F.L. footy to be taken in the mid-season draft. Having two players drafted (with a draft still to come) is an outstanding result. We set ourselves an objective to have more players drafted than any other state league club and we're proud we were able to deliver on that.

We're equally as proud of our ability to have staff elevated from our program to the elite level. We truly are a pathway club, designed to expose talented individuals to the elite level while supporting them with great mentors. Ultimately, we want them to work in the A.F.L. or other sports full time. This season, five staff spent time in the program setting themselves up for the next step in their career. Jack Prato (Football Analyst) moved on to Collingwood's A.F.L. program securing a full-time job, Hussain Khan (Head Doctor) secured the Head Doctor position at Melbourne Victory in the A-League, Andy Collins joined Hawthorn as Head of Development under newly appointed A.F.L. Senior Coach, Sam Mitchell who gained so much from his Box Hill experience and John Cavarra (Football Operations) joined Hawthorn's A.F.L. program in the Football Operations team.

These achievements would not be possible without the support of our Board of Directors lead by President Mr. Ed Sill and Vice President Mr. Kevin Keaney. I'd personally like to thank them all for their on-going support of the Club, football program and staff individually.

Our club was fortunate to have Sam Mitchell join as Senior Coach for 2021 in a dual role as Hawthorn's Head of Development. Sam brought plenty of passion to the role but importantly a level of professionalism that improved the performance of not only players but staff. The Box Hill Hawks continues to have the strongest alignment in the A.F.L./V.F.L.; having recently signed a 5-year extension with the Hawthorn Football Club. Justin Reeves (CEO), Rob McCartney (Head of Football) and all the staff at Hawthorn across all areas of the football program ensure we continue to deliver a high performing environment for both Hawthorn and Box Hill players.

To Bec Goddard, congratulations on being appointed Hawthorn's inaugural A.F.L.W. Coach. Although we didn't finish as high on the ladder as possible, in 2021 we had three players drafted to the elite system and this is something to be very proud of. We also made a commitment to female coaches appointing an all-female coaching panel in 2021 and this is something we should all be proud of at the Hawks. I can't wait to work with these coaches again in 2022.

Both became very valuable V.F.L. players for Box Hill and great Club people more importantly. We wish them all the best and trust we'll be seeing them at City Oval for years to come.

V.F.L. Senior Coach's Report

'What might have been...' is a popular refrain in a sporting context, usually reserved for campaigns which come up short. The type where you feel brought undone by a cruel or quirky twist of fate like the bounce of a ball, luck of the draw or an inconvenient run of injuries.

Following a 2020 season ruined before it could start, 2021 would be denied the resolution it was building to. When the curtain was drawn the Hawks owned the third-best record and percentage in the league, the second-best attack and active winning streak, a foothold in the top four and had key players in form and/or returning to full fitness.

For all the ups, downs, stops and starts, when it was said and done what did 2021 come to represent for the Box Hill Hawks? 2021 will be remembered and celebrated for the growth and maturing of individuals and the hum of a Club perfectly in sync. The home-grown talents of Vincent Adduci, Brayden Kilpatrick and Stuart Horner – veterans in the VFL context, but all young men – produced career-best campaigns. A.F.L.-listed stars of tomorrow showed their hands, too, with stand-out contributions from Emerson Jeka and Josh Morris giving their developing careers the perfect platform from which to attack 2022.

Captain Damian Mascitti set the standard on and off-field. Every bit the consummate professional, Mascitti featured in each of the Club's 10 matches and was deployed wherever the team needed him. His consistency was duly rewarded with a maiden Col Austen Trophy. New faces Fergus Greene and Hugh Beasley held down key posts at either end of the field to great effect, leading by example to support and chaperone their younger teammates.

Then there's the extraordinary story of Jai Newcombe. So fanciful in the re-telling you'd be forgiven for mistaking it for fiction. The kid from Poowong who had never even been to the M.C.G. blazed a trail from South Gippsland to Box Hill and onwards to the game's greatest stage.

As for the on-field highlights, there are a couple that will live long in the memory. Six goals down at half-time of the Round 3 game at Sandringham, the team rallied to win by five goals. In Round 5 against the Kangaroos, Box Hill produced a stirring 10-goal final term; the following week the brown and gold piled on 14 goals in a row in a runaway victory against the Blues at Princes Park. Come half-time of the Round 10 game against Essendon at Windy Hill the Hawks killed off their hosts to lead by 10 goals; in Round 16 against Collingwood a 63-point win was underscored by nine unanswered in the last quarter.

The V.F.L.'s longest running and most successful alignment finished the year believing something special was there for the taking. It will begin 2022 in the same frame of mind.

Captain Meg Hutchins celebrated her milestone 250th game in Round 8, a monumental achievement in women's sport. Hutchins also called time on her decorated career at the end of the campaign. Football fans from all over the league were excited to celebrate and recognise her contribution to women's football in Victoria.

At the V.F.L.W.'s best and fairest awards, Tamara Luke was named the Club winner – an impressive feat considering she only joined the Hawks in Round 6. Brown finished second in the count, following a stand-out season. Unsurprisingly, Hutchins finished third – a testament to her impact on her team and the Club.

With the announcement of Bec Goddard as Hawthorn's first A.F.L.W. coach, and the retirement of Captain Meg Hutchins, season 2022 will certainly have a different flavour. However, the support that Hawthorn has shown towards its women's program in recent years shows that Hawthorn V.F.L.W. mean serious business in seasons to come.
