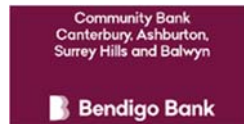

## V.F.L. Senior Coach's Report

The 2024 VFL season was one of milestones and achievements for the Box Hill Hawks, but it was also one of bittersweet endings. While the Club celebrated twenty-five years of alignment with Hawthorn and saw two of its young guns drafted to the AFL, the season concluded in a manner that left the team and its supporters longing for more.

### A Season of Progress

The season began with optimism as the Hawks assembled a strong, dynamic list blending youthful promise and experienced leadership. Their draft selections to AFL clubs were a proud moment for Box Hill, affirming the Club's role in nurturing elite talent. While their departures left gaps in the team, it also underscored Box Hill's enduring ability to develop players capable of excelling on the biggest stage.

### A Heartbreaking Finish

Despite moments of brilliance and the clear growth of many players, the season didn't conclude as we had hoped. After a promising run, the team fell short in our elimination final, leaving supporters wondering what might have been. While the on-field results didn't align with the Club's ambitions, the resilience and fight shown throughout the year highlighted the spirit of the Box Hill Hawks.

This year, we saw some outstanding performances that defined our season. A standout moment was our dominant 108-point win against Casey in Round 1, where Miz Kendall was the star, kicking five goals. We also enjoyed two impressive victories over Geelong—one away and one at home in Box Hill. In both matches, we kept Geelong goalless, winning by 90 and 96 points, respectively.

Perhaps the most memorable game of the season came against Carlton at Ikon Park. This thrilling team performance secured a win that set the tone for the rest of our campaign. Another highlight was our final-round match against Port Melbourne at TEAC Oval, which ended in a dramatic draw after a nail-biting contest.

We faced Port Melbourne again the following week at home, but unfortunately, we were eliminated from Finals after a tough loss. Despite this setback, the season was full of individual standout performances.

Tam Luke was a key player, making the Team of the Year, finishing runner-up in the Lambert-Pearce Medal for VFLW Best and Fairest, and winning our own Best and Fairest award. Tam's impressive season culminated in her being drafted to Richmond, which was a well-deserved recognition.

Another standout was Caity Thorne, who played exceptional football for us before being picked up mid-season by Geelong as an injury replacement. Caity continued her career with Geelong, signing on for another year, and earned a spot in the Team of the Year.

At our Best and Fairest night, several other players were recognised for their contributions: Rosie Dillon won the Best Finals Player award and finished third in the overall vote count, while Danica Spamer, in her first year of VFLW football after relocating from New South Wales, was our runner-up.

As with any season, there are always changes, and we wish the best to those who are moving on from the program. We are already looking forward to 2025 and the pursuit of another Premiership with the Box Hill Hawks.

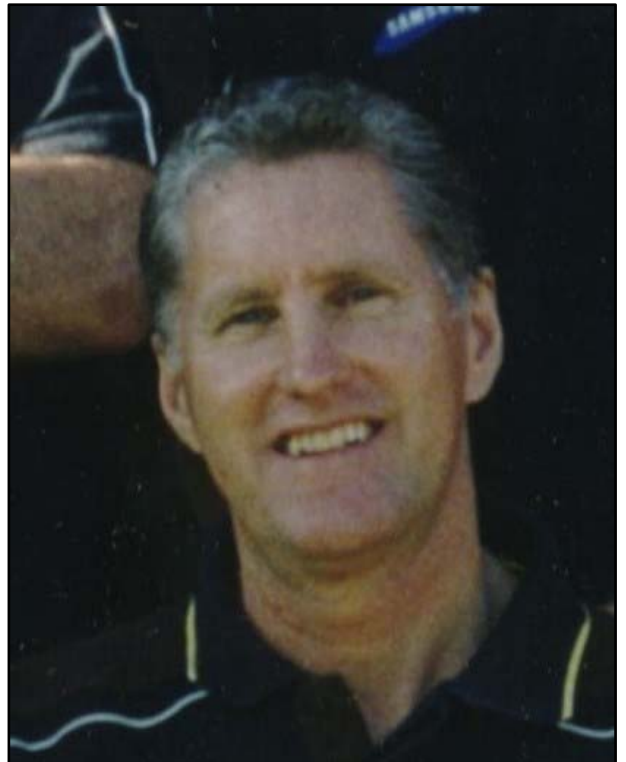
